THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1139. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 2 (2), THE SCHOOL OFFICIALS OF A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE
- 3 REASONABLE ACCESS TO THE HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS, AND ACCESS TO PUPIL
- 4 DIRECTORY INFORMATION OF THE PUPILS ENROLLED IN THE HIGH SCHOOL,
- 5 TO OFFICIAL RECRUITING REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 6 FOR THE PURPOSE OF INFORMING PUPILS OF EDUCATIONAL AND CAREER
- 7 OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE IN THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 9 (B) THE SERVICE ACADEMIES OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED

- 1 (2) IF A HIGH SCHOOL PUPIL OR THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN

- 4 EMPLOYEES TO NOTIFY MALE PUPILS AGE 18 OR OLDER THAT THEY ARE
- 5 REQUIRED TO REGISTER FOR THE SELECTIVE SERVICE.
- 6 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 7 (A) "ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES" INCLUDES THE ARMED
- 8 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES AND THEIR RESERVE COMPONENTS AND THE
- 9 UNITED STATES COAST GUARD.
- 10 (B) "PUPIL DIRECTORY INFORMATION" MEANS A PUPIL'S NAME AND
- 11 ADDRESS AND, IF IT IS A LISTED OR PUBLISHED TELEPHONE NUMBER, THE
- 12 PUPIL'S TELEPHONE NUMBER.
