by amending section 648 (MCL 257.648).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 648. (1) The driver of a vehicle or bicycle upon a
- 2 highway, before stopping or turning from a direct line, shall
- 3 first see that the stopping or turning can be made in safety and
- 4 shall give a signal as required in this section. AS USED IN THIS
- 5 SECTION, "TURNING FROM A DIRECT LINE" INCLUDES CHANGING LANES ON

- (2) A signal required in this section shall be given either

- 1 signal is given by means of the hand and arm, the driver shall
- 2 indicate his or her intention to stop or turn by extending his

- 5 (a) Left turn hand and arm extended horizontally.
- 6 (b) Right turn hand and arm extended upward.
- 7 (c) Stop or decrease speed hand and arm extended
- 8 downward.
- 9 (3) A commercial motor vehicle, other than those in transit
- 10 from a manufacturer to a dealer, in use on a highway shall be
- 11 equipped with, and required signal shall be given by, a signal
- 12 lamp or mechanical signal device when the distance from the
