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3 (3) The office of financial and insurance services shall develop a plan whereby the office informs consumers of their 4 rights regarding insurance coverage of automobile repairs, that 5 the insurer is not required to pay more than a reasonable amount 6 7 for repairs and parts, and of the insured's ability to report violations of their rights to the office of financial and 8 9 insurance services through the office's toll-free telephone 10 number or website. The plan shall be developed and submitted to 11 the senate and house of representatives standing committees on insurance issues not later than 6 months after the effective date 12 13 of this section.
