## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2855a. (1) A person shall not release or make public an autopsy photograph of a decedent that identifies the decedent by name, face, or other identifying physical feature unless 1 of the following conditions is met:
- 5 (a) One of the following persons specifically provides 6 written authorization for the release or publication:
  - (i) The decedent's parent, surviving spouse, guardian, personal representative, or next of kin.

(ii) If a person described in subparagraph (i) cannot be identified or located following a diligent and good faith effort to identify or locate him or her, an individual charged by law
