

# HOUSE BILL No. 4953

July 15, 2003, Introduced by Reps. Richardville, Accavitti, Spade, Rocca, Wojno, Gaffney, Condino, Bieda, Tobocman, Kolb, Law, Shaffer and Gielegem and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 16z of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16z), as amended by 2002 PA 271.
