- (a) The low-protein modified food products are prescribed for the therapeutic treatment of amino acid disorders.
- (b) The low-protein modified food products are administered under the direction of a physician.
- (2) Coverage under this section shall not have deductibles and copayment provisions that are less favorable than those for

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- 1 prescription coverage generally. Coverage under this section may
- 2 be limited to a cap of \$4,000.00 per plan year on low-protein
- 3 modified foods. This \$4,000.00 cap shall be adjusted annually by
- 4 the commissioner pursuant to the consumer price index.

- 6 (a) "Consumer price index" means the percentage of change in
