THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 92. (1) From the state school aid fund appropriation
- 2 in section 11, there is allocated an amount not to exceed

- 4 under this section. In addition, available federal funds are
- 5 appropriated for this purpose.
- 6 (2) To receive a grant under this section, a district shall
 - apply to the department in the form and manner prescribed by the

- 9 Programs funded with grants awarded under this section shall meet

 - (a) The program shall use the funds for hiring and training

- 1 school safety officers and mental health professionals for
