- 6 PERSON is unable to write, -his- THE PERSON'S proper mark,
- 7 <<WHICH MAY BE, UNLESS OTHERWISE EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED BY LAW>>, A CLEAR AND CLASSIFIABLE FINGERPRINT
- 8 OF THE PERSON MADE WITH INK OR ANOTHER SUBSTANCE.
