## HOUSE BILL NO. 5956

## A bill to amend 1945 PA 231, entitled

"An act to prescribe additional regulations and requirements for pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers and junk dealers; to provide for the taking of fingerprints and the making of reports to enforcement officers; to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act; and to declare the effect of this act,"

by amending sections 1 and 6 (MCL 445.471 and 445.476).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) This act shall be construed as supplementing the
- 2 laws of this state and city and village ordinances and charters
- 3 regulating OR LICENSING pawnbrokers, secondhand dealers, and junk
- 4 dealers.
- 5 (2) The term "secondhand AS USED IN THIS ACT:
- 6 (A) "SECONDHAND dealer" or "junk dealer" as used in this act
- 7 shall mean MEANS any person, corporation, or member or members of
- 8 a co-partnership or firm, whose principal business is that of

- 1 purchasing, storing, selling, exchanging, and receiving -second
- 2 hand SECONDHAND personal property of any kind or description. The
- 3 term "pawnbroker" as used in this act shall mean SECONDHAND DEALER
- 4 OR JUNK DEALER DOES NOT INCLUDE A SCRAP PROCESSOR.
- 5 (B) "PAWNBROKER" MEANS any person, corporation, or member or
- 6 members of a co-partnership or firm, who loans money on deposit or
- 7 pledge of personal property, or other valuable thing, other than
- 8 securities or printed evidence of indebtedness, or who deals in the
- 9 purchasing of personal property or other valuable thing on
- 10 condition of selling the same back again at a stipulated price.
- 11 (C) "INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE" MEANS A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR
- 12 FIRM THAT CONTRACTS WITH OTHER PERSONS, CORPORATIONS, OR FIRMS TO
- 13 OFFER ITS PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING FOR SALE,
- 14 PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE THROUGH MEANS OF AN INTERNET
- 15 WEBSITE AND MEETS THE CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 6(3).
- 16 (D) "LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS THE POLICE AGENCY OF
- 17 THE CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP, OR IF NONE, THE COUNTY SHERIFF OF
- 18 THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE CONDUCTS BUSINESS.
- 19 (E) "SCRAP PROCESSOR" MEANS A PERSON, UTILIZING MACHINERY AND
- 20 EQUIPMENT AND OPERATING FROM A FIXED LOCATION, WHOSE PRINCIPAL
- 21 BUSINESS IS THE PROCESSING AND MANUFACTURING OF IRON, STEEL,
- 22 NONFERROUS METALS, PAPER, PLASTIC, OR GLASS, INTO PREPARED GRADES
- 23 OF PRODUCTS SUITABLE FOR CONSUMPTION BY RECYCLING MILLS AND
- 24 FOUNDRIES.
- 25 Sec. 6. (1) Nothing in this act shall be deemed to THIS ACT
- 26 DOES NOT apply to any secondhand or junk dealer purchasing scrap
- 27 iron and metal, except scrapped motor vehicles not purchased from a

- 1 licensed <u>second hand</u> **SECONDHAND** or junk dealer.
- 2 (2) THIS ACT DOES NOT REQUIRE AN INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE
- 3 COMPLYING WITH SUBSECTION (3), OR A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE,
- 4 PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER
- 5 VALUABLE THING FOR HIMSELF OR HERSELF, TO OBTAIN A LICENSE UNDER
- 6 THIS ACT OR ANY ORDINANCE BEING SUPPLEMENTED BY THIS ACT.
- 7 (3) AN INTERNET DROP-OFF STORE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE
- 8 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS IS EXEMPT FROM LICENSURE AS A PAWNBROKER,
- 9 SECONDHAND DEALER, OR JUNK DEALER UNDER THIS ACT:
- 10 (A) HAS A FIXED PLACE OF BUSINESS WITHIN THIS STATE EXCEPT
- 11 THAT HE OR SHE EXCLUSIVELY TRANSACTS ALL PURCHASES OR SALES BY
- 12 MEANS OF THE INTERNET AND THE PURCHASES AND SALES ARE NOT
- 13 PHYSICALLY TRANSACTED ON THE PREMISES OF THAT FIXED PLACE OF
- 14 BUSINESS.
- 15 (B) HAS THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING
- 16 AVAILABLE ON A WEBSITE FOR VIEWING BY PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, BY
- 17 THE GENERAL PUBLIC AT NO CHARGE, WHICH WEBSITE SHALL BE SEARCHABLE
- 18 BY ZIP CODE OR STATE, OR BOTH. THE WEBSITE VIEWING SHALL INCLUDE,
- 19 AS APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE, MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE
- 20 IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR LETTERS APPEARING ON THE
- 21 PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.
- 22 (C) MAINTAINS RECORDS OF THE SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR
- 23 TRADE OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING FOR AT LEAST
- 24 2 YEARS, WHICH RECORDS SHALL CONTAIN A DESCRIPTION, INCLUDING A
- 25 PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, AND, IF APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE,
- 26 MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR
- 27 LETTERS APPEARING ON THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.

- 1 (D) PROVIDE THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY WITH ANY NAME
- 2 UNDER WHICH IT CONDUCTS BUSINESS ON THE WEBSITE, ACCESS TO THE
- 3 BUSINESS PREMISES AT ANY TIME DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS FOR
- 4 PURPOSES OF INSPECTION, AND, WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER ENTERING INTO
- 5 THE CONTRACT FOR THE SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE OF THE
- PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING, AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF
- 7 THE SELLER'S OR CONSIGNOR'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, DRIVER
- LICENSE NUMBER AND ISSUING STATE, AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PERSONAL 8
- 9 PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING AS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (C).
- 10 THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION SHALL BE IN A FORMAT ACCEPTABLE TO THE
- 11 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BUT SHALL AT LEAST BE IN A LEGIBLE
- 12 FORMAT AND IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.
- 13 (E) PROVIDE THAT PAYMENT FOR THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER
- VALUABLE THING IS EXECUTED BY MEANS OF CHECK OR OTHER ELECTRONIC 14
- 15 PAYMENT SYSTEM, SO LONG AS THE PAYMENT IS NOT MADE IN CASH.
- (F) IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE 16
- THING FROM THE WEBSITE AND NOTIFY THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY 17
- 18 UPON LEARNING IF THE VERIFICATION REVEALS THAT THE PERSONAL
- 19 PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING IS STOLEN.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
- 22 enacted into law:
