HOUSE BILL No. 4092

February 1, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Virgil Smith and Murphy and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled

"The Michigan penal code,"

by amending sections 224 and 227 (MCL 750.224 and 750.227), section 224 as amended by 1991 PA 33 and section 227 as amended by 1986 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 224. (1) A person shall not manufacture, sell, offer for
 sale, or possess any of the following:

(a) A machine gun or firearm that shoots or is designed to shoot automatically more than 1 shot without manual reloading, by a single function of the trigger.

- (b) A muffler or silencer.
- (c) A bomb or bombshell.

(d) A blackjack, slungshot, billy, metallic knuckles, sand
 club, sand bag, or bludgeon.

3 (e) A device, weapon, cartridge, container, or contrivance
4 designed to render a person temporarily or permanently disabled by
5 the ejection, release, or emission of a gas or other substance.

6 (F) ANY SHARP-EDGED, MULTIBLADED DEVICE, CAPABLE OF BEING
7 CARRIED ON THE PERSON, WITH BLADES THAT ARE, OR CAN BE, LOCKED INTO
8 PLACE FOR USE AS A WEAPON.

9 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is guilty of a felony
10 , punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years , or a
11 fine of not more than \$2,500.00, or both.

(E) A PERSON MANUFACTURING, SELLING, OFFERING TO SELL, OR
POSSESSING A DEVICE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)(F) IN THE COURSE OF
A LAWFUL TRADE, PROFESSION, OR OCCUPATION.

(4) As used in this chapter, "muffler" or "silencer" means 1

2 (a) A device for muffling, silencing, or deadening the report3 of a firearm.

4 (b) A combination of parts, designed or redesigned, and
5 intended for use in assembling or fabricating a muffler or
6 silencer.

7 (c) A part, designed or redesigned, and intended only for use8 in assembling or fabricating a muffler or silencer.

9 Sec. 227. (1) A person shall not carry a dagger, A dirk, A 10 stiletto, a double-edged nonfolding stabbing instrument of any 11 length, A SHARP-EDGED MULTIBLADED DEVICE WITH BLADES CAPABLE OF 12 BEING LOCKED INTO PLACE FOR USE AS A WEAPON, or any other dangerous 13 weapon, except a hunting knife adapted and carried as -such A 14 HUNTING KNIFE, concealed on or about his or her person ---- or, 15 whether concealed or otherwise, in any vehicle operated or occupied 16 by the person, except in his or her dwelling house -, OR place of 17 business or on other land possessed by the person.

18 (2) A person shall not carry a pistol concealed on or about 19 his or her person -, or, whether concealed or otherwise, in a 20 vehicle operated or occupied by the person, except in his or her 21 dwelling house --- OR place of business --- or on other land 22 possessed by the person, without a license to carry the pistol as 23 provided by law and, if licensed, shall not carry the pistol in a 24 place or manner inconsistent with any restrictions upon -such THE 25 license.
