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HOUSE BILL No. 4276

February 15, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Vander Veen, Sheltrown, Taub and Drolet and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled "The state school aid act of 1979," by amending section 25c (MCL 388.1625c), as added by 2001 PA 121; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 25c. (1) Beginning in 2000-2001, this THIS section applies to an educating district's enrollment of a pupil if the educating district is a school district of the first class under the revised school code and if all of the following apply:
- (a) The pupil transfers from another district and enrolls in the educating district after the pupil membership count day.
 - (b) Due to the pupil's enrollment status as of the pupil

- 1 membership count day, the pupil was counted in membership in the
- 2 district from which he or she transfers.
- 3 (c) The pupil was a resident of the educating district on the
- 4 pupil membership count day or met other eligibility criteria under
- 5 section 6(4) or (6) to be counted in membership in the educating
- 6 district if the pupil had been enrolled in the educating district
- 7 on the pupil membership count day.
- 8 (d) The total number of pupils enrolled in the district who
- 9 are described in subdivisions (a), (b), and (c) is at least equal
- 10 to 25.
- 11 (2) If the conditions specified in subsection (1) are met, and
- 12 a pupil transfers from another district and enrolls during a school
- 13 year in the educating district, the educating district shall report
- 14 the enrollment information to the department and to the district in
- 15 which the pupil is counted in membership, and the district in which
- 16 the pupil is counted in membership shall pay to the educating
- 17 district an amount equal to the amount of the foundation allowance
- 18 or per pupil payment as calculated under section 20 for the
- 19 district in which the pupil is counted in membership, prorated
- 20 according to the number of days of the school year ending in the
- 21 fiscal year the pupil is educated in the educating district
- 22 compared to the number of days of the school year ending in the
- 23 fiscal year the pupil was actually enrolled in the district in
- 24 which the pupil is counted in membership. The foundation allowance
- 25 or per pupil payment shall be adjusted by the pupil's full-time
- 26 equated status as affected by the membership definition under
- 27 section 6(4). If a district does not make the payment required

- 1 under this section within 30 days after receipt of the report, the
- 2 department shall calculate the amount owed, shall deduct that
- 3 amount from the remaining state school aid payments to the district
- 4 for that fiscal year under this act, and shall pay that amount to
- 5 the educating district. The district in which the pupil is counted
- 6 in membership and the educating district shall provide to the
- 7 department all information the department requires to enforce this
- 8 section.
- 9 (3) In determining the total amount a district owes to the
- 10 educating district under this section, regardless of whether that
- 11 district is otherwise eligible for payment from the educating
- 12 district under this section, the district may calculate and
- 13 subtract from the amount owed, using the calculation described in
- 14 subsection (1), any amount applicable to pupils who transfer to
- 15 that district from the educating district and meet the requirements
- 16 of subsection $\frac{(1)(a)}{(a)}$ to $\frac{(c)}{(a)}$.
- 17 (4) As used in this section, "educating district" means the
- 18 district in which a pupil enrolls after the pupil membership count
- 19 day as described in subsection (1).
- 20 Enacting section 1. Section 25b of the state school aid act
- 21 of 1979, 1979 PA 94, MCL 388.1625b, is repealed.
