## HOUSE BILL No. 5073

## August 3, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Williams, Phillips, Gonzales and Alma Smith and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to protect and promote the health and welfare of infants; to provide for training of certain individuals regarding infant safety; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and agencies.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. As used in this act:

(a) "Child care organization", "child caring institution","children's camp", "child care center", "day care center", "familyday care home", and "group day care home" mean those terms asdefined in section 1 of 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111.

(b) "Department" means the department of community health.

(c) "Person who has significant interaction with children" means a person who is 1 or more of the following:

Sec. 2. The department shall include in a class or training program offered to a person who has significant contact with children a course in infant cardiopulmonary resuscitation approved by the department and offered or approved by the Red Cross, American heart association, a licensed hospital, or a comparable organization or institution.

Sec. 3. The department may contract with a private agency,corporation, or association in order to comply with this act.
