HOUSE BILL No. 5343

October 20, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Hildenbrand, Elsenheimer, Stakoe, Casperson, Baxter, Nitz and Walker and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Forestry, and Outdoor Recreation.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 81101 (MCL 324.81101), as amended by 2003 PA 111, and by adding section 81101a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 81101. As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "ATV" means a $\frac{3}{3}$ or $\frac{4}{3}$ wheeled 3-WHEEL, 4-WHEEL, OR 6-
- 3 WHEEL vehicle designed for off-road use that has low-pressure
- 4 tires, has A BENCH SEAT OR a seat designed to be straddled by the
- 5 rider, and is powered by a 50cc to -500cc 900CC gasoline engine or
 - an engine of comparable size using other fuels.
- 7 (b) "Code" means the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
- 3 257.1 to 257.923.

- 1 (c) "Dealer" means a person engaged in the sale, lease, or
- 2 rental of an ORV as a regular business or, for purposes of selling
- 3 licenses under section 81116, any other person authorized by the
- 4 department to sell licenses or permits, or both, under this act.
- 5 (d) "Designated", unless the context implies otherwise, means
- 6 posted open for ORV use with appropriate signs by the department.
- 7 (e) "Forest road" means a hard surfaced road, gravel or dirt
- 8 road, or other route capable of travel by a 2-wheel drive, 4-wheel
- 9 conventional vehicle designed for highway use, except an
- 10 interstate, state, or county highway.
- 11 (f) "Forest trail" means a designated path or way capable of
- 12 travel only by a vehicle less than 50 inches 60 INCHES OR LESS in
- 13 width.
- 14 (g) "Highway" means the entire width between the boundary
- 15 lines of a way publicly maintained when any part of the way is open
- 16 to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.
- 17 (h) "Highly restricted personal information" means an
- 18 individual's photograph or image, social security number, digitized
- 19 signature, and medical and disability information.
- 20 (i) "Late model ORV" means an ORV manufactured in the current
- 21 model year or the 5 model years immediately preceding the current
- 22 model year.
- (j) "Manufacturer" means a person, partnership, corporation,
- 24 or association engaged in the production and manufacture of ORVs as
- 25 a regular business.
- 26 (k) "Operate" means to ride in or on, and be in actual
- 27 physical control of, the operation of an ORV.

- 1 (1) "Operator" means a person who operates or is in actual
- 2 physical control of the operation of an ORV.
- 3 (m) "ORV" or "vehicle" means a motor driven off-road
- 4 recreation vehicle capable of cross-country travel without benefit
- 5 of a road or trail, on or immediately over land, snow, ice, marsh,
- 6 swampland, or other natural terrain. ORV or vehicle includes, but
- 7 is not limited to, a multitrack or multiwheel drive vehicle, an
- 8 ATV, a motorcycle or related 2-wheel, 3-wheel, -or 4-wheel, OR 6-
- 9 WHEEL vehicle, an amphibious machine, a ground effect air cushion
- 10 vehicle, or other means of transportation deriving motive power
- 11 from a source other than muscle or wind. ORV or vehicle does not
- 12 include a registered snowmobile, a farm vehicle being used for
- 13 farming, a vehicle used for military, fire, emergency, or law
- 14 enforcement purposes, a vehicle owned and operated by a utility
- 15 company or an oil or gas company when performing maintenance on its
- 16 facilities or on property over which it has an easement, a
- 17 construction or logging vehicle used in performance of its common
- 18 function, or a registered aircraft.
- 19 (n) "Owner" means any of the following:
- 20 (i) A vendee or lessee of an ORV $\frac{\text{which}}{\text{that}}$ is the subject of
- 21 an agreement for the conditional sale or lease of the ORV, with the
- 22 right of purchase upon performance of the conditions stated in the
- 23 agreement, and with an immediate right of possession vested in the
- 24 conditional vendee or lessee.
- 25 (ii) A person renting an ORV, or having the exclusive use of an
- 26 ORV, for more than 30 days.
- 27 (iii) A person who holds legal ownership of an ORV.

- 1 (o) "Person with disabilities" means a person who has 1 or
- 2 more of the following physical characteristics:
- (i) Blindness.
- 4 (ii) Inability to ambulate more than 200 feet without having to
- 5 stop and rest during any time of the year.
- 6 (iii) Loss of use of 1 or both legs or feet.
- 7 (*iv*) Inability to ambulate without the prolonged use of a
- 8 wheelchair, walker, crutches, braces, or other device required to
- 9 aid mobility.
- 10 (v) A lung disease from which the person's expiratory volume
- 11 for 1 second, when measured by spirometry, is less than 1 liter, or
- 12 from which the person's arterial oxygen tension is less than 60
- 13 mm/hg of room air at rest.
- (vi) A cardiovascular disease from which the person measures
- 15 between 3 and 4 on the New York heart classification scale, or from
- 16 which a marked limitation of physical activity causes fatigue,
- 17 palpitation, dyspnea, or anginal pain.
- 18 (vii) Other diagnosed disease or disorder including, but not
- 19 limited to, severe arthritis or a neurological or orthopedic
- 20 impairment that creates a severe mobility limitation.
- 21 (p) "Personal information" means information that identifies
- 22 an individual, including an individual's driver identification
- 23 number, name, address not including zip code, and telephone number,
- 24 but does not include information on ORV operation or equipment-
- 25 related violations or civil infractions, operator or vehicle
- 26 registration status, accidents, or other behaviorally-related
- 27 information.

- 1 (q) "Public agency" means the department or AN AGENCY OF a
- 2 local -or federal unit of government OR OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
- 3 (r) "Roadway" means that portion of a highway improved,
- 4 designated, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel. If a highway
- 5 includes 2 or more separate roadways, the term roadway refers to a
- 6 roadway separately, but not to all roadways collectively.
- 7 (s) "Route" means a forest road or other road that is
- 8 designated for purposes of this part by the department.
- 9 (t) "Safety education fund" means the safety education fund
- 10 created under section 81118.
- 11 (u) "Safety chief instructor" means a person who has been
- 12 certified by a nationally recognized ATV and ORV organization to
- 13 certify instructors and to do on-sight evaluations of instructors.
- 14 (v) "Trail improvement fund" means the ORV trail improvement
- 15 fund created -pursuant to UNDER section 81117.
- 16 (w) "Visual supervision" means the direct observation of the
- 17 operator with the unaided or normally corrected eye, where the
- 18 observer is able to come to the immediate aid of the operator.
- 19 SEC. 81101A. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 20 (A) "ATV" MEANS A 3-WHEEL, 4-WHEEL, OR 6-WHEEL VEHICLE
- 21 DESIGNED FOR OFF-ROAD USE THAT HAS LOW-PRESSURE TIRES, HAS A BENCH
- 22 SEAT OR A SEAT DESIGNED TO BE STRADDLED BY THE RIDER, AND IS
- 23 POWERED BY A 50CC TO 900CC GASOLINE ENGINE OR AN ENGINE OF
- 24 COMPARABLE SIZE USING OTHER FUELS.
- 25 (B) "CODE" MEANS THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL
- 26 257.1 TO 257.923.
- 27 (C) "DEALER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE, LEASE, OR

- 1 RENTAL OF AN ORV AS A REGULAR BUSINESS OR, FOR PURPOSES OF SELLING
- 2 LICENSES UNDER SECTION 81116, ANY OTHER PERSON AUTHORIZED BY THE
- 3 DEPARTMENT TO SELL LICENSES OR PERMITS, OR BOTH, UNDER THIS ACT.
- 4 (D) "DESIGNATED", UNLESS THE CONTEXT IMPLIES OTHERWISE, MEANS
- 5 POSTED OPEN FOR ORV USE WITH APPROPRIATE SIGNS BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 6 (E) "FOREST ROAD" MEANS A HARD SURFACED ROAD, GRAVEL OR DIRT
- 7 ROAD, OR OTHER ROUTE CAPABLE OF TRAVEL BY A 2-WHEEL DRIVE, 4-WHEEL
- 8 CONVENTIONAL VEHICLE DESIGNED FOR HIGHWAY USE, EXCEPT AN
- 9 INTERSTATE, STATE, OR COUNTY HIGHWAY.
- 10 (F) "FOREST TRAIL" MEANS A DESIGNATED PATH OR WAY CAPABLE OF
- 11 TRAVEL ONLY BY A VEHICLE 60 INCHES OR LESS IN WIDTH.
- 12 (G) "HIGHWAY" MEANS THE ENTIRE WIDTH BETWEEN THE BOUNDARY
- 13 LINES OF A WAY PUBLICLY MAINTAINED WHEN ANY PART OF THE WAY IS OPEN
- 14 TO THE USE OF THE PUBLIC FOR PURPOSES OF VEHICULAR TRAVEL.
- 15 (H) "HIGHLY RESTRICTED PERSONAL INFORMATION" MEANS AN
- 16 INDIVIDUAL'S PHOTOGRAPH OR IMAGE, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DIGITIZED
- 17 SIGNATURE, AND MEDICAL AND DISABILITY INFORMATION.
- 18 (I) "LATE MODEL ORV" MEANS AN ORV MANUFACTURED IN THE CURRENT
- 19 MODEL YEAR OR THE 5 MODEL YEARS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE CURRENT
- 20 MODEL YEAR.
- 21 (J) "MANUFACTURER" MEANS A PERSON, PARTNERSHIP, CORPORATION,
- 22 OR ASSOCIATION ENGAGED IN THE PRODUCTION AND MANUFACTURE OF ORVS AS
- 23 A REGULAR BUSINESS.
- 24 (K) "OFF-ROAD VEHICLE ACCOUNT" MEANS THE OFF-ROAD VEHICLE
- 25 ACCOUNT OF THE MICHIGAN CONSERVATION AND RECREATION LEGACY FUND
- 26 PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 2015.
- 27 (1) "OPERATE" MEANS TO RIDE IN OR ON, AND BE IN ACTUAL PHYSICAL

- 1 CONTROL OF, THE OPERATION OF AN ORV.
- 2 (M) "OPERATOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO OPERATES OR IS IN ACTUAL
- 3 PHYSICAL CONTROL OF THE OPERATION OF AN ORV.
- 4 (N) "ORV" OR "VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR DRIVEN OFF-ROAD
- 5 RECREATION VEHICLE CAPABLE OF CROSS-COUNTRY TRAVEL WITHOUT BENEFIT
- 6 OF A ROAD OR TRAIL, ON OR IMMEDIATELY OVER LAND, SNOW, ICE, MARSH,
- 7 SWAMPLAND, OR OTHER NATURAL TERRAIN. ORV OR VEHICLE INCLUDES, BUT
- 8 IS NOT LIMITED TO, A MULTITRACK OR MULTIWHEEL DRIVE VEHICLE, AN
- 9 ATV, A MOTORCYCLE OR RELATED 2-WHEEL, 3-WHEEL, 4-WHEEL, OR 6-WHEEL
- 10 VEHICLE, AN AMPHIBIOUS MACHINE, A GROUND EFFECT AIR CUSHION
- 11 VEHICLE, OR OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION DERIVING MOTIVE POWER
- 12 FROM A SOURCE OTHER THAN MUSCLE OR WIND. ORV OR VEHICLE DOES NOT
- 13 INCLUDE A REGISTERED SNOWMOBILE, A FARM VEHICLE BEING USED FOR
- 14 FARMING, A VEHICLE USED FOR MILITARY, FIRE, EMERGENCY, OR LAW
- 15 ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES, A VEHICLE OWNED AND OPERATED BY A UTILITY
- 16 COMPANY OR AN OIL OR GAS COMPANY WHEN PERFORMING MAINTENANCE ON ITS
- 17 FACILITIES OR ON PROPERTY OVER WHICH IT HAS AN EASEMENT, A
- 18 CONSTRUCTION OR LOGGING VEHICLE USED IN PERFORMANCE OF ITS COMMON
- 19 FUNCTION, OR A REGISTERED AIRCRAFT.
- 20 (O) "OWNER" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (i) A VENDEE OR LESSEE OF AN ORV THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF AN
- 22 AGREEMENT FOR THE CONDITIONAL SALE OR LEASE OF THE ORV, WITH THE
- 23 RIGHT OF PURCHASE UPON PERFORMANCE OF THE CONDITIONS STATED IN THE
- 24 AGREEMENT, AND WITH AN IMMEDIATE RIGHT OF POSSESSION VESTED IN THE
- 25 CONDITIONAL VENDEE OR LESSEE.
- 26 (ii) A PERSON RENTING AN ORV, OR HAVING THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF AN
- 27 ORV, FOR MORE THAN 30 DAYS.

- 1 (iii) A PERSON WHO HOLDS LEGAL OWNERSHIP OF AN ORV.
- 2 (P) "PERSON WITH DISABILITIES" MEANS A PERSON WHO HAS 1 OR
- 3 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS:
- 4 (i) BLINDNESS.
- 5 (ii) INABILITY TO AMBULATE MORE THAN 200 FEET WITHOUT HAVING TO
- 6 STOP AND REST DURING ANY TIME OF THE YEAR.
- 7 (iii) LOSS OF USE OF 1 OR BOTH LEGS OR FEET.
- 8 (iv) INABILITY TO AMBULATE WITHOUT THE PROLONGED USE OF A
- 9 WHEELCHAIR, WALKER, CRUTCHES, BRACES, OR OTHER DEVICE REQUIRED TO
- 10 AID MOBILITY.
- 11 (v) A LUNG DISEASE FROM WHICH THE PERSON'S EXPIRATORY VOLUME
- 12 FOR 1 SECOND, WHEN MEASURED BY SPIROMETRY, IS LESS THAN 1 LITER, OR
- 13 FROM WHICH THE PERSON'S ARTERIAL OXYGEN TENSION IS LESS THAN 60
- 14 MM/HG OF ROOM AIR AT REST.
- 15 (vi) A CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE FROM WHICH THE PERSON MEASURES
- 16 BETWEEN 3 AND 4 ON THE NEW YORK HEART CLASSIFICATION SCALE, OR FROM
- 17 WHICH A MARKED LIMITATION OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY CAUSES FATIGUE,
- 18 PALPITATION, DYSPNEA, OR ANGINAL PAIN.
- 19 (vii) OTHER DIAGNOSED DISEASE OR DISORDER INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 20 LIMITED TO, SEVERE ARTHRITIS OR A NEUROLOGICAL OR ORTHOPEDIC
- 21 IMPAIRMENT THAT CREATES A SEVERE MOBILITY LIMITATION.
- 22 (Q) "PERSONAL INFORMATION" MEANS INFORMATION THAT IDENTIFIES
- 23 AN INDIVIDUAL, INCLUDING AN INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVER IDENTIFICATION
- 24 NUMBER, NAME, ADDRESS NOT INCLUDING ZIP CODE, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER,
- 25 BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE INFORMATION ON ORV OPERATION OR EQUIPMENT-
- 26 RELATED VIOLATIONS OR CIVIL INFRACTIONS, OPERATOR OR VEHICLE
- 27 REGISTRATION STATUS, ACCIDENTS, OR OTHER BEHAVIORALLY-RELATED

- 1 INFORMATION.
- 2 (R) "PUBLIC AGENCY" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OR AN AGENCY OF A
- 3 LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT OR OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
- 4 (S) "ROADWAY" MEANS THAT PORTION OF A HIGHWAY IMPROVED,
- 5 DESIGNATED, OR ORDINARILY USED FOR VEHICULAR TRAVEL. IF A HIGHWAY
- 6 INCLUDES 2 OR MORE SEPARATE ROADWAYS, THE TERM ROADWAY REFERS TO A
- 7 ROADWAY SEPARATELY, BUT NOT TO ALL ROADWAYS COLLECTIVELY.
- 8 (T) "ROUTE" MEANS A FOREST ROAD OR OTHER ROAD THAT IS
- 9 DESIGNATED FOR PURPOSES OF THIS PART BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 10 (U) "SAFETY CHIEF INSTRUCTOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN
- 11 CERTIFIED BY A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED ATV AND ORV ORGANIZATION TO
- 12 CERTIFY INSTRUCTORS AND TO DO ON-SIGHT EVALUATIONS OF INSTRUCTORS.
- 13 (V) "VISUAL SUPERVISION" MEANS THE DIRECT OBSERVATION OF THE
- 14 OPERATOR WITH THE UNAIDED OR NORMALLY CORRECTED EYE, WHERE THE
- 15 OBSERVER IS ABLE TO COME TO THE IMMEDIATE AID OF THE OPERATOR.
- 16 Enacting section 1. Section 81101 of the natural resources and
- 17 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.81101, is
- 18 repealed upon House Joint Resolution Z of the 92nd Legislature
- 19 becoming a part of the state constitution of 1963 as provided in
- 20 section 1 of article XII of the state constitution of 1963.
- 21 Enacting section 2. Section 81101a of the natural resources
- 22 and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, as added by this
- 23 amendatory act, does not take effect unless House Joint Resolution
- 24 Z of the 92nd Legislature becomes a part of the state constitution
- 25 of 1963 as provided in section 1 of article XII of the state
- 26 constitution of 1963.
