## **HOUSE BILL No. 5614**

January 25, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Van Regenmorter and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 295, entitled

"Sex offenders registration act,"

by amending section 8 (MCL 28.728), as amended by 2004 PA 240.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8. (1) The department shall maintain a computerized
- 2 database of registrations and notices required under this act.
- 3 (2) The department shall maintain a computerized database
- 4 separate from that described in subsection (1) to implement section
- 5 10(2) and (3). Except as provided in subsection (3), the database
- 6 shall consist of a compilation of individuals registered under this
- 7 act.

- (3) The database described in subsection (2) shall not include
- the following individuals:

- 1 (a) An individual registered solely because he or she had 1 or
- 2 more dispositions for a listed offense entered under section 18 of
- 3 chapter XIIA of the probate code of 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 712A.18,
- 4 in a case that was not designated as a case in which the individual
- 5 was to be tried in the same manner as an adult under section 2d of
- 6 chapter XIIA of the probate code of 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 712A.2d.
- 7 Except as provided in subdivision (b), the exclusion for juvenile
- 8 dispositions does not apply to a disposition for a violation of
- 9 section 520b or 520c of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL
- 10 750.520b and 750.520c, after the individual becomes 18 years of

- 12 (b) An individual who is exempt under section 8d from that

- 14 (4) The compilation of individuals shall be indexed
- 15 numerically by zip code area. Within each zip code area, the
- 16 compilation shall contain all of the following information:
- 17 (a) The name and aliases, address, physical description, and
- 18 birth date of each individual registered under this act who is
- 19 included in the compilation and who resides in that zip code area
- 20 and any listed offense of which the individual has been convicted.
- 21 (b) The name and campus location of each institution of higher
- 22 education to which the individual is required to report under
- 23 section 4a.
- 24 (c) Beginning May 1, 2005, the photograph of each individual
- 25 registered under this act. The department shall obtain the
- 26 photographs submitted under section 5a from the secretary of state
- 27 for purposes of implementing this subdivision.

- 1 (D) THE DATE EACH INDIVIDUAL COMMITTED THE LISTED OFFENSE OR
- 2 LISTED OFFENSES.
- 3 (5) The department shall update the compilation with new
- 4 registrations, deletions from registrations, and address changes at
- 5 the same time those changes are made to the database described in
- 6 subsection (1). The department shall make the compilation available
- 7 to each department post, local law enforcement agency, and
- 8 sheriff's department by the law enforcement information network.
- 9 Upon request by a department post, local law enforcement agency, or
- 10 sheriff's department, the department shall provide to that post,
- 11 agency, or sheriff's department the information from the
- 12 compilation in printed form for the zip code areas located in whole
- or in part within the post's, agency's, or sheriff's department's
- 14 jurisdiction. The department shall provide the ability to conduct a
- 15 computerized search of the compilation based upon the name and
- 16 campus location of an institution of higher education described in
- 17 subsection (4)(b).
- 18 (6) The department shall make the compilation or information
- 19 from the compilation available to a department post, local law
- 20 enforcement agency, sheriff's department, and the public by
- 21 electronic, computerized, or other similar means accessible to the
- 22 post, agency, or sheriff's department. The electronic,
- 23 computerized, or other similar means shall provide for both a
- 24 search by name and by zip code.
- 25 (7) If a court determines that the public availability under
- 26 section 10 of any information concerning individuals registered
- 27 under this act, including names and aliases, addresses, physical

- 1 descriptions, or dates of birth, violates the constitution of the
- 2 United States or this state, the department shall revise the
- 3 compilation in subsection (2) so that it does not contain that
- 4 information.
