HOUSE BILL No. 5958

April 19, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Nofs, Hildenbrand, Palsrok and Clemente and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1981 PA 95, entitled

"The precious metal and gem dealer act,"

by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 445.482 and 445.483), section 2 as amended by 1990 PA 34.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Agent or employee" means a person who, for compensation
- 3 or valuable consideration, is employed either directly or
- 4 indirectly by a dealer.
- 5 (b) "Dealer" means any person, corporation, partnership, or
- 6 association, which, in whole or in part, engages in the ordinary
- 7 course of repeated and recurrent transactions of buying or
 - receiving precious items from the public within this state.

- 1 (c) "Gold" means elemental gold having an atomic weight of
- 2 196.967 and the chemical element symbol of Au, whether found by
- 3 itself or in combination with its alloys or any other metal.
- 4 (d) "Jewelry" means an ornamental item made of a material that
- 5 includes a precious gem.
- 6 (e) "Local governmental unit" means a city, village, township,
- 7 or county.
- 8 (f) "Local police agency" means the police agency of the city,
- 9 village, or township, or if none, the county sheriff of the county,
- in which the dealer conducts business.
- 11 (q) "Platinum" means elemental platinum having an atomic
- 12 weight of 195.09 and the chemical element symbol of Pt, whether
- 13 found by itself or in combination with its alloys or any other
- 14 metal.
- (h) "Precious gem" means a diamond, alexandrite, ruby,
- 16 sapphire, opal, amethyst, emerald, aquamarine, morganite, garnet,
- 17 jadeite, topaz, tourmaline, turquoise, or pearl.
- (i) "Precious item" means jewelry, a precious gem, or an item
- 19 containing gold, silver, or platinum. Precious item does not
- 20 include the following:
- 21 (i) Coins, commemorative medals, and tokens struck by, or in
- 22 behalf of, a government or private mint.
- 23 (ii) Bullion bars and discs of the type traded by banks and
- 24 commodity exchanges.
- 25 (iii) Items at the time they are purchased directly from a
- 26 dealer registered under this act, a manufacturer, or a wholesaler
- 27 who purchased them directly from a manufacturer.

- 1 (iv) Industrial machinery or equipment.
- 2 (v) An item being returned to or exchanged at the dealer where
- 3 the item was purchased and which THAT is accompanied by a valid
- 4 sales receipt.
- 5 (vi) An item which is received for alteration, redesign, or
- 6 repair in a manner that does not substantially change its use and
- 7 returned directly to the customer.
- 8 (vii) An item which does not have a jeweler's identifying mark
- 9 or a serial mark and which the dealer purchases for less than
- **10** \$5.00.
- 11 (viii) Scrap metal which contains incidental traces of gold,
- 12 silver, or platinum -which THAT are recoverable as a by-product.
- 13 (ix) Jewelry which a customer trades for other jewelry having a
- 14 greater value, and which difference in value is paid by the
- 15 customer.
- 16 (j) "Silver" means elemental silver having an atomic weight of
- 17 107.869 and the chemical element symbol of Ag, whether found by
- 18 itself or in combination with its alloys or any other metal.
- 19 (K) "TRADING ASSISTANT" MEANS A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR FIRM
- 20 THAT CONTRACTS WITH OTHER PERSONS, CORPORATIONS, OR FIRMS TO OFFER
- 21 ITS PRECIOUS ITEMS FOR SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE
- 22 THROUGH MEANS OF AN INTERNET WEBSITE AND MEETS THE CONDITIONS
- 23 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 3(3).
- Sec. 3. (1) A dealer shall not conduct business in a -city,
- 25 village, or township LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL UNIT in this state unless
- 26 the dealer has obtained a valid certificate of registration from
- 27 that local -city, village GOVERNMENTAL UNIT or -township LOCAL

- 1 police agency.
- 2 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A TRADING ASSISTANT
- 3 COMPLYING WITH SUBSECTION (3), OR A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE SALE,
- 4 PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE OF PRECIOUS ITEMS FOR HIMSELF OR
- 5 HERSELF, TO OBTAIN A REGISTRATION UNDER THIS ACT.
- 6 (3) A TRADING ASSISTANT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING
- 7 CONDITIONS IS EXEMPT FROM REGISTRATION AS A DEALER UNDER THIS ACT:
- 8 (A) HAS A FIXED PLACE OF BUSINESS WITHIN THIS STATE.
- 9 (B) HAS THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING
- 10 AVAILABLE ON A WEBSITE FOR VIEWING BY PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, BY
- 11 THE GENERAL PUBLIC AT NO CHARGE, WHICH WEBSITE SHALL BE SEARCHABLE
- 12 BY ZIP CODE OR STATE, OR BOTH. THE WEBSITE VIEWING SHALL INCLUDE,
- 13 AS APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE, MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE
- 14 IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR LETTERS APPEARING ON THE
- 15 PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.
- 16 (C) MAINTAINS RECORDS OF THE SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR
- 17 TRADE OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING FOR AT LEAST
- 18 2 YEARS, WHICH RECORDS SHALL CONTAIN A DESCRIPTION, INCLUDING A
- 19 PHOTOGRAPH, IF AVAILABLE, AND, IF APPLICABLE, SERIAL NUMBER, MAKE,
- 20 MODEL, AND OTHER UNIQUE IDENTIFYING MARKS, NUMBERS, NAMES, OR
- 21 LETTERS APPEARING ON THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING.
- 22 (D) PROVIDE THE LOCAL POLICE AGENCY WITH ANY NAME UNDER WHICH
- 23 IT CONDUCTS BUSINESS ON THE WEBSITE, ACCESS TO THE BUSINESS
- 24 PREMISES AT ANY TIME DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS FOR PURPOSES OF
- 25 INSPECTION, AND, WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER ENTERING INTO THE CONTRACT
- 26 FOR THE SALE, PURCHASE, CONSIGNMENT, OR TRADE OF THE PERSONAL
- 27 PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING, AN ELECTRONIC COPY OF THE NAME,

- 1 ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER AND ISSUING STATE,
- 2 AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE THING AS
- 3 DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (C). THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION SHALL BE
- 4 IN A FORMAT ACCEPTABLE TO THE LOCAL POLICE AGENCY BUT SHALL AT
- 5 LEAST BE IN A LEGIBLE FORMAT AND IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE.
- 6 (E) PROVIDE THAT PAYMENT FOR THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER
- 7 VALUABLE THING IS EXECUTED BY MEANS OF CHECK OR OTHER ELECTRONIC
- 8 PAYMENT SYSTEM, SO LONG AS THE PAYMENT IS NOT MADE IN CASH.
- 9 (F) IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR OTHER VALUABLE
- 10 THING FROM THE WEBSITE AND NOTIFY THE LOCAL POLICE AGENCY UPON
- 11 LEARNING IF THE VERIFICATION REVEALS THAT THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OR
- 12 OTHER VALUABLE THING IS STOLEN.
- 13 (4) -(2) A dealer shall apply to the local police agency for
- 14 a certificate of registration, and pay a fee not to exceed \$50.00
- 15 to cover the reasonable cost of processing and issuing the
- 16 certificate of registration, by disclosing the following
- 17 information:
- 18 (a) The name, address, and thumbprint of the applicant.
- 19 (b) The name and address under which the applicant does
- 20 business.
- 21 (c) The name, address, and thumbprint of all agents or
- 22 employees of the dealer. Within 24 hours after hiring a new
- 23 employee, the dealer shall forward to the local police agency the
- 24 name, address, and thumbprint of the new employee.
- 25 (5) -(3) A dealer or an agent or employee of a dealer who is
- 26 convicted of a misdemeanor under this act or under section 535 of
- 27 Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, being section

- 1 750.535 of the Michigan Compiled Laws THE MICHIGAN PENAL CODE,
- 2 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.535, shall not be permitted to operate as a
- 3 dealer within this state for a period of 1 year after conviction.
- 4 (6) -(4) A dealer or an agent or employee of a dealer who is
- 5 convicted of a felony under this act or under section 535 of Act
- 6 No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as amended, THE MICHIGAN PENAL
- 7 CODE, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.535, shall not be permitted to operate
- 8 as a dealer within this state for a period of 5 years after the
- 9 conviction.
- 10 (7) $\overline{(5)}$ This act shall not be construed to excuse a dealer
- 11 from complying with the local zoning ordinance or any local
- 12 ordinance regulating commercial activities. However, a local
- 13 government may not pass an ordinance, or enforce an existing
- 14 ordinance, that provides additional standards which must be met
- 15 before the issuance of a certificate of registration.
- 16 (8) -(6)— Upon receipt of the application described in
- 17 subsection -(2) (4), the local police agency shall issue a
- 18 certificate of registration in accordance with this section.
- 19 (9) -(7) Upon receipt of the certificate of registration from
- 20 the local police agency, the dealer shall post it in a conspicuous
- 21 place in the dealer's place of business.
- 22 (10) -(8) Not less than 10 days before a dealer changes the
- 23 name or address under which the dealer does business, the dealer
- 24 shall notify the local police agency of the change.
- 25 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 26 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
