HOUSE BILL No. 6092

May 18, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Nitz and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code,"

by amending section 1205 (MCL 339.1205), as amended by 1997 PA 97.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1205. (1) The department shall issue a license to a
- 2 person for the operation of a school of cosmetology if all of the
- 3 following requirements are met:
- 4 (a) An application is submitted by the owner or manager of the
- 5 school.
- **6** (b) The application includes a drawing or diagram that
- 7 indicates the premises to be licensed, showing that the premises
- 8 are fully partitioned from any other activity, business, or
- 9 dwelling. The location of required equipment and facilities shall
- 10 also be shown on the diagram.

- 1 (c) A cash or surety bond of \$10,000.00 has been furnished in
- 2 favor of the people of this state for the use and benefit of
- 3 students and conditioned upon the faithful performance and
- 4 satisfaction of the contractual rights of students.
- 5 (d) Provisions have been made for the school to be under the
- 6 daily supervision of a licensed instructor who has at least 3
- 7 years' experience in all services of cosmetology being taught in
- 8 the school.
- 9 (e) The premises has successfully passed an inspection by the
- 10 department conducted for the purpose of determining whether the
- 11 school has met the standards set forth in this article and rules
- 12 promulgated by the director.
- 13 (2) A school of cosmetology shall fulfill all of the following
- 14 requirements:
- 15 (a) Shall maintain a course of practical training and
- 16 technical instruction, as outlined in the various curricula set
- 17 forth in rules promulgated by the director, equal to the
- 18 requirements for prelicensure training under this article. A school
- 19 of cosmetology shall teach hair care services, skin care services,
- 20 and manicuring services and may hold a limited license for the
- 21 teaching of electrology OR SKIN CARE SERVICES. However, a school of
- 22 cosmetology with a license limited only to the teaching of
- 23 electrology OR SKIN CARE SERVICES shall teach only electrology OR
- 24 SKIN CARE SERVICES and not any other cosmetology service.
- 25 (b) Shall possess efficient apparatus and equipment prescribed
- 26 in rules promulgated by the director sufficient for the ready and
- 27 full teaching of each subject in the curriculum.

- 1 (c) Shall maintain 1 person licensed as an instructor,
- 2 competent to impart instruction in each subject of its curriculum,
- 3 for every 20 students.
- 4 (d) Shall be operated for teaching purposes only. Instructors
- 5 shall practice on the public only to demonstrate techniques to
- 6 students and to correct the work of students.
- 7 (e) Shall provide for the display of the license of the school
- 8 of cosmetology and of each instructor working in the school in a
- 9 prominent place that is visible to the public at all times. A sign
- 10 shall be displayed indicating that services are rendered by
- 11 students of the school.
- 12 (f) At the time of the enrollment of a student, shall furnish
- 13 the student a financial contract showing the total cost and all
- 14 charges involved in the complete course of study. Advertising
- 15 matter put out by schools, when mentioning the cost of tuition or
- 16 related subjects, shall furnish the same financial information as
- 17 described in this subsection.
- 18 (3) A cosmetology establishment exacting a fee for the
- 19 teaching of cosmetology or 1 or more services of cosmetology is
- 20 considered a school of cosmetology and is required to comply with
- 21 this section. A cosmetology establishment conducting an
- 22 apprenticeship program without charging a fee for the teaching of
- 23 cosmetology shall comply with subsection (5). A cosmetology
- 24 establishment which has successfully trained 1 apprentice is
- 25 eligible to train additional apprentices except that a cosmetology
- 26 establishment shall not have more than 2 apprentices at the same
- **27** time.

- 1 (4) The department may issue a limited school of cosmetology
- 2 license to a school teaching only electrology OR SKIN CARE
- 3 SERVICES. A school of cosmetology whose license is limited to
- 4 teaching only electrology OR SKIN CARE SERVICES shall fulfill all
- 5 of the requirements of this section, except that daily supervision
- 6 of the school shall be provided by an electrology OR SKIN CARE
- 7 SERVICES instructor and the curriculum offered and equipment and
- 8 facilities required shall be only those required for the teaching
- 9 of electrology OR SKIN CARE SERVICES.
- 10 (5) A school of cosmetology or a cosmetology establishment
- 11 conducting an apprenticeship program shall comply with all of the
- 12 following requirements:
- 13 (a) Require that a student or apprentice be in attendance not
- 14 more than 7 hours per day or not more than 40 hours per week.
- (b) Keep a daily record of the attendance of each student or
- 16 apprentice, a copy of which shall be sent to the department
- 17 monthly, establish grades, and require a student or apprentice to
- 18 pass an examination before certifying to the department that an
- 19 individual has completed training.
- (c) Permit a cosmetology student or apprentice to practice on
- 21 the public only after completing at least 350 hours of instruction
- 22 in the general cosmetology curriculum, including both theory and
- 23 practical hours. A student or apprentice in a natural hair
- 24 cultivation, manicuring, skin care, or electrology curriculum may
- 25 practice on the public only after completing at least 1 of the
- 26 hours required by the applicable curriculum, including both theory
- 27 and practical hours.

- 1 (6) The transfer of ownership or location of a school of
- 2 cosmetology voids the license. The filing of a new license
- 3 application is a predicate to the change in ownership or location
- 4 of a school.
