HOUSE BILL No. 6256

June 22, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Hummel and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 653b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 653B. (1) UPON APPROACHING AND PASSING A STATIONARY SOLID

- PROCEEDING IN THE SAME DIRECTION OF THE STATIONARY SOLID WASTE
