SENATE BILL No. 149

February 2, 2005, Introduced by Senators TOY, BIRKHOLZ, BROWN, BASHAM, HARDIMAN, McMANUS, GARCIA, ALLEN, GOSCHKA, OLSHOVE, KUIPERS and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 803e, 803f, 803j, 803k, 803l, 803n, and 803o (MCL 257.803e, 257.803f, 257.803j, 257.803k, 257.803l, 257.803n, and 257.803o), section 803e as amended by 2003 PA 30, section 803f as amended by 1998 PA 68, sections 803j, 803k, 803n, and 803o as amended by 1999 PA 183, and section 803l as amended by 2000 PA 77.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a
 person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application
 to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which
 shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by
 the letters "EX-POW" and shall have the words "ex-prisoner of war"

1 inscribed beneath the registration number.

(2) A person who was a member of the armed services during
World War I may make application APPLY to the secretary of state
for a special registration plate, which shall be inscribed with
special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and
shall have the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the
registration number.

(3) A person who was a member of the armed services during 8 9 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment 10 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the 11 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make 12 application APPLY to the secretary of state for a special 13 registration plate, which shall be inscribed with special 14 identification numbers and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor 15 survivor" inscribed beneath the registration number.

(4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may 16 17 make application APPLY to the secretary of state for a special 18 registration plate, which shall be inscribed with special 19 identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded 20 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition, the special registration plate described under this subsection 21 22 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart medal. 23

(5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state — and shall be
accompanied by <u>any</u> proof <u>of</u> SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF
STATE THAT the applicant <u>having been</u> IS OR WAS a prisoner of war,

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World War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, or recipient of the
 purple heart medal. that the secretary of state may require. The
 application for a special registration plate shall also be
 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

5 (6) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service 6 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application APPLIES 8 9 for a special registration plate under this section and who makes 10 payment of PAYS the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for 11 persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or 12 her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall 13 require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as 14 is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under 15 section 675. One person in any household is entitled to 1 special registration plate issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from 16 17 payment of the tax provided in section 801. The person who is 18 issued an additional special registration plate under subsection 19 (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided for in section 20 801. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under 21 subsection (2), (3), or (4) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801. 22

(7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

26 (8) The special registration plate issued under this section27 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new

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plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for
 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant is not required to AGAIN furnish
 the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection (5).

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5 Sec. 803f. (1) A person who is a totally disabled veteran with 6 an honorable discharge from the armed services may make an application APPLY to the secretary of state if he or she owns a 7 private passenger motor vehicle, and the secretary of state may 8 9 issue a special registration plate, which shall be inscribed with 10 special identification numbers preceded by the letters "DV" and 11 shall have the words "disabled veteran" inscribed beneath the 12 registration number. For the purposes of this section, "private 13 14 personally owned by the disabled veteran and is used for the 15 primary purpose of transporting the disabled veteran and family 16 members of the disabled veteran, but does not include a motor home. 17 (2) Application for the special registration plate shall be on

18 a form prescribed by the secretary of state — and shall be 19 accompanied by a service fee of \$5.00 and proof SATISFACTORY TO THE 20 SECRETARY OF STATE that the applicant was honorably discharged from 21 the armed services and either 1 of the following:

(a) That the applicant has been determined by the veterans'
administration of the federal government to have a serviceconnected total or permanent total disability rating for
compensation.

26 (b) That the applicant has been determined to have a service-27 connected total or permanent total disability rating and is

receiving disability retirement pay from a branch of the uniformed
 armed services.

3 (3) A special registration issued under this section is exempt4 from payment of the tax provided in section 801.

5 (4) The special registration plate <u>shall expire</u> EXPIRES on 6 the birthday of the disabled veteran in a year in which new plates 7 are issued by the secretary of state. Application for renewal of 8 the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 9 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to AGAIN 10 furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection (2).

11 (5) The secretary of state may issue to a disabled person who 12 has been issued a special registration plate under this section a 13 tab for persons with disabilities. The tab for persons with 14 disabilities shall be an adhesive tab displaying the international 15 wheelchair symbol or a reasonable facsimile of that symbol. The tab for persons with disabilities may be attached only to the special 16 17 registration plate issued to the disabled person under this 18 section.

19 (6) An application for a tab for persons with disabilities
20 shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state. The
21 secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant
22 is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent
23 windshield placard under section 675.

24 (7) The tab for persons with disabilities shall be issued free25 of charge.

26 (8) When a disabled person who has been issued a tab for27 persons with disabilities renews his or her special registration

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1 plate under this section, the secretary of state shall issue a new 2 tab for persons with disabilities to the disabled person, free of 3 charge. The disabled person shall not be required to again furnish 4 the proof required under subsection (6).

5 (9) The use of the special registration plate or a tab for
6 persons with disabilities on a motor vehicle other than the motor
7 vehicle for which the special registration plate is issued, or by a
8 person who does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

9 Sec. 803j. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services 10 or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed forces during 11 the Korean War may make application APPLY to the secretary of 12 state for a special registration plate, which shall display an 13 appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall 14 have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state —, and shall be
accompanied by <u>any</u> proof <u>of</u> SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF
STATE THAT the applicant or the applicant's spouse <u>having been</u> IS
OR WAS a Korean War veteran. <u>that the secretary of state may</u>
require. The application for a special registration plate shall
also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

(3) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application APPLIES
for a special registration plate under this section and who makes
payment of PAYS the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for

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persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under subsection (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.

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8 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
9 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
10 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(5) The special registration plate issued under this section shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to AGAIN furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection (2).

Sec. 803k. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War may make application APPLY to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state —, and shall be
accompanied by <u>any</u> proof <u>of</u> SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF

STATE THAT the applicant or applicant's spouse <u>having been</u> IS OR
 WAS a Vietnam War veteran. <u>that the secretary of state may</u>
 require. The application for a special registration plate shall
 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

5 (3) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service 6 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application APPLIES 8 9 for a special registration plate under this section and who makes 10 payment of PAYS the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for 11 persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or 12 her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as 13 14 is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under 15 section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under subsection (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided 16 17 in section 801.

18 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
19 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
20 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(5) The special registration plate issued under this section shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to AGAIN furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection (2).

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Sec. 8031. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services during World War II or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during World War II may make application APPLY to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

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8 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
9 form prescribed by the secretary of state —, and shall be
10 accompanied by <u>any</u> proof <u>of</u> SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF
11 STATE THAT the applicant or applicant's spouse <u>having been</u> IS OR
12 WAS a World War II veteran. <u>that the secretary of state may</u>
13 require. The application for a special registration plate shall
14 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

15 (3) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 special registration 16 plate for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person 17 18 who is disabled who makes application APPLIES for a special 19 registration plate under this section and who makes payment of 20 PAYS the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special 21 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same 22 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for 23 24 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued a special registration plate under subsection (1) 25 shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801. 26 27 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other

than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

3 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section
4 shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When
5 new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for
6 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
7 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to
8 AGAIN furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection
9 (2).

10 Sec. 803n. (1) A person who was a member or a person whose spouse was a member of the Michigan national guard, the United 11 12 States armed forces reserve, or any branch of the armed services of the United States and who was called to active duty during the 13 14 Persian Gulf War may apply to the secretary of state for a special 15 registration plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word 16 17 "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) A person who was a member or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during the conflict in Grenada, the conflict in Panama, or the conflict in Lebanon may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(3) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state —, and shall be
accompanied by <u>any</u> proof <u>of</u> SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF

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STATE THAT the applicant or applicant's spouse <u>having been</u> IS OR
 WAS a war or conflict veteran. <u>that the secretary of state may</u>
 require. The application for a special registration plate shall
 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

5 (4) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service 6 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special 8 9 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00 10 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as 11 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. 12 The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a 13 14 permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 15 or more special registration plates under subsection (1) or (2) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801. 16

17 (5) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other18 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who19 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(6) The special registration plate issued under this section shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to AGAIN furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection (3).

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Sec. 8030. (1) On and after December 18, 1992, a person who

1 was a member or a person whose spouse was a member of the Michigan 2 national quard, the United States armed forces reserve, or any 3 branch of the armed services of the United States and who was 4 called to active duty during a declared war or an armed conflict in 5 which the United States was a participant may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate, which shall 6 display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers 7 and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the 8 9 registration numbers.

10 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 11 form prescribed by the secretary of state -, and shall be 12 accompanied by -any- proof -of- SATISFACTORY TO THE SECRETARY OF 13 STATE THAT the applicant or applicant's spouse having been IS OR 14 WAS a veteran of a declared war or an armed conflict in which the 15 United States was a participant. - that the secretary of state may require. The application for a special registration plate shall 16 17 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.

18 (3) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service 19 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 20 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special 21 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00 22 23 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as 24 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the 25 applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a 26 27 permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1

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or more special registration plates under subsection (1) shall be
 assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.

3 (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
4 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
5 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

6 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section 7 shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When 8 new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for 9 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a 10 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant <u>shall</u> IS not <u>be</u> required to 11 AGAIN furnish the proof <u>provided in</u> REQUIRED UNDER subsection 12 (2).
