THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 41305. (1) Unless EXCEPT AS authorized by a permit 2 issued by the department under this section SUBSECTION (2) or 3 section 48735, a person shall not knowingly release or allow to be released into this state any of the following that is not 4 5 naturalized in the location of release: 6 (a) A genetically engineered fish. (b) A nonnative fish. INTRODUCE A GENETICALLY ENGINEERED OR 7 NONNATIVE FISH, INSECT, OR AQUATIC PLANT, KNOWING THAT THE ORGANISM 8

3	subsection (1) on a form developed by the department. The
4	application shall be accompanied by a fee established by the
