## **SENATE BILL No. 847**

October 26, 2005, Introduced by Senators JELINEK, KUIPERS, GOSCHKA, VAN WOERKOM and ALLEN and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 81129 (MCL 324.81129), as amended by 2003 PA
111.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 81129. (1) Subject to subsections (2), (3), -and (17),
- 2 AND (18), a parent or legal guardian of a child less than 16 years
- 3 of age shall not permit the child to operate an ORV unless the
- 4 child is under the direct visual supervision of an adult and the
- 5 child has in his or her immediate possession an ORV safety
- 6 certificate issued pursuant to this part or a comparable ORV safety
- 7 certificate issued under the authority of another state or a
- 8 province of Canada.
  - (2) A parent or legal guardian of a child less than 12 years

- 1 of age shall not permit the child to operate a 4-wheeled ATV,
- 2 unless the child is not less than 10 years of age and, SUBJECT TO
- 3 SUBSECTION (18), is on private land owned by a parent or legal
- 4 guardian of the child. This subsection does not apply to the
- 5 operation of an ATV used in agricultural operations.
- 6 (3) A parent or legal guardian of a child less than 16 years
- 7 of age shall not permit the child to operate a 3-wheeled ATV.
- 8 (4) Subject to subsections (5), (6), -and (17), AND (18), the
- 9 owner or person in charge of an ORV shall not knowingly permit the
- 10 vehicle to be operated by a child less than 16 years of age unless
- 11 the child is under the direct visual supervision of an adult and
- 12 the child has in his or her immediate possession an ORV safety
- 13 certificate issued pursuant to this part or a comparable ORV safety
- 14 certificate issued under the authority of another state or a
- 15 province of Canada.
- 16 (5) The SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (18), THE owner or person in
- 17 charge of a 4-wheeled ATV shall not knowingly permit the vehicle to
- 18 be operated by a child less than 12 years of age, unless the child
- 19 is not less than 10 years of age and is on private land owned by a
- 20 parent or legal guardian of the child. This subsection does not
- 21 apply to the operation of an ATV used in agricultural operations.
- 22 (6) The owner or person in charge of a 3-wheeled ATV shall not
- 23 knowingly permit the vehicle to be operated by a child less than 16
- 24 years of age.
- 25 (7) The owner or person in charge of an ORV shall not
- 26 knowingly permit the vehicle to be operated by a person who is
- 27 incompetent to operate the vehicle because of mental or physical

- 1 disability except as provided in section 81131.
- 2 (8) The department shall implement a comprehensive ORV
- 3 information, safety education, and training program that shall
- 4 include the training of operators and the preparation and
- 5 dissemination of information and safety advice to the public. The
- 6 program shall provide for the training of youthful operators and
- 7 for the issuance of ORV safety certificates to those who
- 8 successfully complete the training provided under the program and
- 9 may include separate instruction for each type of ORV.
- 10 (9) In implementing a program that is established pursuant to
- 11 this section, the department shall cooperate with private
- 12 organizations and associations, private and public corporations,
- 13 the department of education, the department of state, and local
- 14 governmental units. The department shall consult with ORV and
- 15 environmental organizations and associations in regard to the
- 16 subject matter of a training program and performance testing that
- 17 leads to certification of ORV operators.
- 18 (10) The department may designate a person it considers
- 19 qualified to provide course instruction and to award ORV safety
- 20 certificates.
- 21 (11) The department may promulgate rules to implement
- 22 subsections (8) to (10) AND (18).
- 23 (12) Subject to subsections (13), (14), -and (17), AND (18),
- 24 a child who is less than 16 years of age may operate an ORV if the
- 25 child is under the direct visual supervision of an adult and the
- 26 child has in his or her immediate possession an ORV safety
- 27 certificate issued pursuant to this section or a comparable ORV

- 1 safety certificate issued under the authority of another state or a
- 2 province of Canada.
- 3 (13) —A— SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (18), A child who is less than
- 4 12 years of age shall not operate a 4-wheeled ATV, unless the child
- 5 is not less than 10 years of age and is on private land owned by a
- 6 parent or legal guardian of the child. This subsection does not
- 7 apply to the operation of an ATV used in agricultural operations.
- 8 (14) A child who is less than 16 years of age shall not
- 9 operate a 3-wheeled ATV.
- 10 (15) When SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (18), WHEN operating an ORV
- 11 under subsection (12), a child shall present the ORV safety
- 12 certificate to a peace officer upon demand.
- 13 (16) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, an
- 14 operator who is less than 12 years of age shall not cross a highway
- 15 or street. An operator who is not less than 12 years of age but
- 16 less than 16 years of age may cross a highway or street or operate
- 17 on the right-of-way or shoulder of designated access routes
- 18 pursuant to section 81131 if the operator has a valid ORV safety
- 19 certificate in his or her immediate possession and meets any other
- 20 requirements under this section for operation of the vehicle.
- 21 (17) The requirement of possession or presentation of an ORV
- 22 safety certificate under this section does not apply until
- 23 implementation of the program for the vehicle proposed to be
- 24 operated required by subsection (8).
- 25 (18) A REQUIREMENT OF THIS SECTION THAT A CHILD BE UNDER THE
- 26 DIRECT VISUAL SUPERVISION OF AN ADULT, POSSESS AN ORV SAFETY
- 27 CERTIFICATE, OR OPERATE AN ORV ON PRIVATE LAND OWNED BY A PARENT OR

- 1 GUARDIAN DOES NOT APPLY IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE
- 2 MET:
- 3 (A) THE CHILD IS PARTICIPATING IN AN ORGANIZED ORV RIDING OR
- 4 RACING EVENT HELD ON LAND NOT OWNED BY THIS STATE.
- 5 (B) THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN HAS PROVIDED THE
- 6 EVENT ORGANIZER WITH WRITTEN PERMISSION FOR THE CHILD TO
- 7 PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT.
- 8 (C) THE EVENT ORGANIZER HAS NOT LESS THAN \$500,000.00
- 9 LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE EVENT.
- 10 (D) A PHYSICIAN OR PHYSICIAN'S ASSISTANT LICENSED OR OTHERWISE
- 11 AUTHORIZED UNDER PART 170 OR 175 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA
- 12 368, MCL 333.17001 TO 333.17084 AND 333.17501 TO 333.17556, OR A
- 13 PARAMEDIC OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN LICENSED UNDER PART 209
- 14 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20901 TO 333.20979,
- 15 IS PRESENT AT THE SITE OF THE EVENT OR AVAILABLE ON CALL.
- 16 (E) THE EVENT IS AT ALL TIMES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF ADULT
- 17 STAFF OF THE EVENT ORGANIZER AND A STAFF MEMBER SERVES AS A FLAGGER
- 18 TO WARN ORV RIDERS IF ANOTHER ORV RIDER IS INJURED OR AN ORV IS
- 19 INOPERABLE IN THE ORV OPERATING AREA.
- 20 (F) FENCING OR ANOTHER MEANS OF CROWD CONTROL IS USED TO KEEP
- 21 SPECTATORS OUT OF THE ORV OPERATING AREA.
- 22 (G) IF THE EVENT IS ON A CLOSED COURSE, DUST IS CONTROLLED IN
- 23 THE ORV OPERATING AREA AND THE RIDING SURFACE IN THE ORV OPERATING
- 24 AREA IS OTHERWISE PROPERLY PREPARED.
- 25 (H) ANY ATVS USED BY PARTICIPANTS ARE EQUIPPED WITH A SIDE
- 26 STEP BAR OR COMPARABLE SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND WITH A TETHER KILL
- 27 SWITCH, AND THE TETHER IS USED BY ALL PARTICIPANTS.

- 1 (I) EACH PARTICIPANT IN THE EVENT WEARS A CRASH HELMET
- 2 APPROVED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, A
- 3 PROTECTIVE LONG-SLEEVED SHIRT OR JACKET, LONG PANTS, BOOTS, AND
- 4 PROTECTIVE GLOVES.
- 5 (J) ANY OTHER APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PART OR RULES
- 6 PROMULGATED UNDER THIS PART ARE MET.
