## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2233. -(1) The department may promulgate rules necessary
- 2 or appropriate to implement and carry out the duties or functions
- 3 vested by law in the department. A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT
- 4 OR AN EXCEPTION TO A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT
- 5 DISCRIMINATE IN FAVOR OF OR AGAINST ANY PROVIDER, FACILITY, OR
- 6 EMPLOYER LICENSED UNDER THIS CODE BASED UPON THE PRESENCE OF, OR
- 7 LACK OF, A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH EMPLOYEES.
- 8 (2) If the Michigan supreme court rules that sections 45 and
- 9 46 of the administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the

- 1 Public Acts of 1969, being sections 24.245 and 24.246 of the
- 2 Michigan Compiled Laws, are unconstitutional, and a statute
- 3 requiring legislative review of administrative rules is not enacted
- 4 within 90 days after the Michigan supreme court ruling, the
- 5 department shall not promulgate rules under this act.
