## **SENATE BILL No. 1448**

September 14, 2006, Introduced by Senators ALLEN, GILBERT, SANBORN, GOSCHKA, BIRKHOLZ, VAN WOERKOM and JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 3104a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3104A. (1) TO ADDRESS CROSS-JURISDICTIONAL WATER QUALITY
- 2 ISSUES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL FACILITATE THE FORMATION OF A GREAT
- 3 LAKES WATER QUALITY COUNCIL. THE COUNCIL SHALL CONSIST OF
- 4 ENVIRONMENTAL AND PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIALS FROM STATE AND LOCAL
- 5 GOVERNMENTS AND CANADIAN PROVINCES WITHIN THE GREAT LAKES REGION.
- 6 THE COUNCIL SHALL RESEARCH AND RECOMMEND PUBLIC POLICY MEASURES TO
- 7 ADDRESS CROSS-JURISDICTIONAL WATER QUALITY ISSUES, INCLUDING, BUT
- 8 NOT LIMITED TO, WATER QUALITY MONITORING, DISCHARGES FROM SEWAGE
- 9 OVERFLOWS AND TOXIC SPILLS, APPROPRIATE INVESTIGATORY PROCEDURES TO
- 10 DETERMINE THE CAUSE AND EXTENT OF THESE DISCHARGES, AND

- 1 APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THESE DISCHARGES.
- 2 THE COUNCIL SHALL ALSO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUNDING AND
- 3 APPROPRIATE ENFORCEMENT MEASURES THAT WILL HELP TO DEVELOP A
- 4 COORDINATED CROSS-JURISDICTIONAL WATER QUALITY PLAN. THE COUNCIL
- 5 MAY SEEK ASSISTANCE FROM OTHER PERSONS AND MAY HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS
- 6 TO GATHER INPUT FROM INTERESTED PARTIES.
- 7 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ANNUALLY SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE
- 8 GOVERNOR AND TO THE STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE LEGISLATURE WITH
- 9 PRIMARY JURISDICTION OVER ISSUES PERTAINING TO NATURAL RESOURCES
- 10 AND THE ENVIRONMENT THAT INCLUDES THE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
- 11 OF THE COUNCIL.
