(1) If, after opportunity for a hearing held 1 2 pursuant to Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, as amended THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO 3 24.328, the commissioner determines that the person complained of 4 has engaged in methods of competition or unfair or deceptive acts 5 6 or practices prohibited by sections 2001 to 2050, the commissioner shall reduce his OR HER findings and decision to writing and shall 7 issue and cause to be served upon the person charged with the 8 violation a copy of the findings and an order requiring the person 9 10 to cease and desist from engaging in that method of competition,
