SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4848

A bill to amend 1986 PA 54, entitled "Building officials and inspectors registration act," by amending section 13 (MCL 338.2313).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 13. (1) The commission shall charge fees for registration
- 2 of building officials, inspectors, and plan reviewers and for the
- 3 examination and evaluation of training and educational programs and
- 4 courses. An applicant for registration shall pay a registration fee
- 5 of \$10.00 \$25.00 a year to the commission for each year the
- 6 registration covers.
- 7 (2) Fees established by the commission shall bear a reasonable
- 8 relation to the cost for conducting training and educational
- 9 programs and courses.

- 1 (3) Fees received by the commission pursuant to this act shall
- 2 be deposited in the state construction code fund created by section
- 3 22 of the STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE state construction code act,
- 4 of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being section
- 5 125.1522 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1522.
- 6 (4) BY JULY 1 OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 7 MULTIPLY THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION BY A
- 8 PERCENTAGE AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AVERAGE PERCENTAGE WAGE AND SALARY
- 9 INCREASE GRANTED TO CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED BY
- 10 THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE FOLLOWING OCTOBER
- 11 1.
- 12 (5) IF THE AMOUNT CALCULATED UNDER SUBSECTION (4) IS LESS THAN
- 13 10% OF THE FEES IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 14 NOT INCREASE THE FEES.
- 15 (6) IF THE CUMULATIVE AMOUNT CALCULATED UNDER SUBSECTION (4)
- 16 SINCE THE MOST RECENT FEE INCREASE EQUALS AT LEAST 10% OF THE FEES
- 17 IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY INCREASE THE AMOUNT
- 18 OF FEES IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE CUMULATIVE AMOUNT
- 19 CALCULATED UNDER SUBSECTION (4).
- 20 (7) IF THE DEPARTMENT INCREASES FEES UNDER SUBSECTION (6), THE
- 21 INCREASE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE
- 22 FOLLOWING OCTOBER 1. THE INCREASED FEES SHALL BE USED BY THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT AS THE BASIS FOR CALCULATING FEE INCREASES IN SUBSEQUENT
- 24 FISCAL YEARS, AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (6).
- 25 (8) BY JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE TO
- 26 THE STATE BUDGET OFFICE, SENATE, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND THE
- 27 SENATE AND HOUSE FISCAL AGENCIES A COMPLETE SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE

- COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE AMOUNT CALCULATED UNDER 1
- SUBSECTION (4), AND THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE INCREASE UNDER SUBSECTION 2
- 3 (6). THE LEGISLATURE HAS 90 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING NOTICE FROM THE
- 4 DEPARTMENT IN WHICH TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE PROPOSED
- 5 INCREASE IN FEES UNDER SUBSECTION (6).
