THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 601. (1) A person shall not engage in or attempt to
 engage in the practice of an occupation regulated under this act or
 use a title designated in this act unless the person possesses a
 license or registration issued by the department for the
 occupation.

6 (2) A school, institution, or person shall not operate or
7 attempt to operate a barber college, school of cosmetology, or real
8 estate school unless the school, institution, or person is licensed
9 or approved by the department.

House Bill No. 4937 (H-1) as amended October 11, 2007 (3) A person, school, or institution that violates subsection (1) or (2) is guilty of a misdemeanor — punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 — or imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.

misdemeanor , punishable, except as provided in section 735, by a

20 (9) (7) As used in subsection (5) (7), "affected person" means 21 a person directly affected by the actions of a person suspected of 22 violating subsection (1) or (2) and includes, but is not limited 23 to, a licensee or registrant, a board established pursuant to this 24 act, a person who has utilized the services of the person engaging 25 in or attempting to engage in an occupation regulated under this 26 act or using a title designated by this act without being licensed 27 or registered by the department, or a private association composed

primarily of members of the occupation in which the person is

(12) (10) An interior designer may perform services in connection with the design of interior spaces including preparation of documents relative to finishes, systems furniture, furnishings, fixtures, equipment, and interior partitions that do not affect the building mechanical, structural, electrical, or fire safety systems.

WITHOUT BEING LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT MAY BRING AN ACTION IN A
