SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4941

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 28.292), as amended by 2005 PA 143.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) The official state personal identification card
- 2 shall contain the following:
- 3 (a) An identification number permanently assigned to the
- 4 person.
- 5 (b) The full **LEGAL** name, date of birth, sex, residential
- 6 RESIDENCE address, height, weight, eye color, DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHIC
- 7 image, and signature of the person to whom the identification card

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1 is issued APPLICANT, AND EXPIRATION DATE OF THE OFFICIAL STATE

- 2 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD.
- 3 (c) An indication that the identification card contains 1 or
- 4 more of the following:
- 5 (i) The blood type of the person.
- 6 (ii) Immunization data of the person.
- 7 (iii) Medication data of the person.
- 8 (iv) A statement that the person is deaf.
- 9 (v) Until January 1, 2007, a statement that the person is an
- 10 organ and tissue donor under part 101 of the public health code,
- 11 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10109. If the identification card
- 12 contains such a statement, the statement shall include the
- 13 signature of the person, along with the signature of at least 1
- 14 witness.
- 15 <u>(vi) Emergency contact information of the person.</u>
- 16 (vii) A sticker or decal as specified by the secretary of state
- 17 to indicate that the holder of the official state personal
- 18 identification card has designated 1 or more patient advocates in
- 19 accordance with section 5506 of the estates and protected
- 20 individuals code, 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.5506, or a statement that he
- 21 or she carries an emergency medical information card, as described
- 22 in subsection (5).
- 23 (d) In the case of a person who is less than 18 years of age
- 24 at the time of issuance of the identification card, the dates on
- 25 which the person will become 18 years of age and 21 years of age.
- 26 (e) In the case of a person who is not less than 18 years of
- 27 age but less than 21 years of age at the time of issuance of the

- 1 identification card, the date on which the person will become 21
- 2 years of age.
- 3 (D) (f) Beginning January 1, 2007, in IN the case of a holder
- 4 of an official state personal identification card who has indicated
- 5 his or her wish to participate in the organ and tissue ANATOMICAL
- 6 GIFT donor registry under part 101 of the public health code, 1978
- 7 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10109 **333.10123**, a heart insignia on
- 8 the front of the official state personal identification card.
- 9 (E) PHYSICAL SECURITY FEATURES DESIGNED TO PREVENT TAMPERING,
- 10 COUNTERFEITING, OR DUPLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL
- 11 IDENTIFICATION CARD FOR FRAUDULENT PURPOSES.
- 12 (2) In conjunction with the application for or, until January
- 13 1, 2007, the issuance of an official state personal identification
- 14 card, the secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- 15 (a) Provide the applicant with all of the following:
- 16 (i) Information explaining the applicant's right to make an
- 17 anatomical gift in the event of death under part 101 of the public
- 18 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10109 333.10123, and
- 19 in accordance with this section.
- 20 (ii) Information describing the organ, tissue, and eye donor
- 21 registry program maintained by Michigan's federally designated
- 22 organ procurement organization or its successor organization UNDER
- 23 SECTION 10120 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 24 333.10120. The information required under this subparagraph
- 25 includes the address and telephone number of Michigan's federally
- 26 designated organ procurement organization or its successor
- 27 organization AS DEFINED IN SECTION 10120 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,

- 1 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10120.
- 2 (iii) Information giving the applicant the opportunity to have
- 3 his or her name placed on the registry described in subparagraph
- **4** (*ii*).
- 5 (b) Provide the applicant with the opportunity to specify on
- 6 his or her official state personal identification card that he or
- 7 she is willing to make an anatomical gift in the event of death
- 8 pursuant to part 101 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 9 333.10101 to 333.10109 **333.10123**, and in accordance with this
- 10 section.
- 11 (c) Inform the applicant that, if he or she indicates to the
- 12 secretary of state under this section a willingness to have his or
- 13 her name placed on the DONOR registry described in subdivision
- 14 (a) (ii), the secretary of state will mark the applicant's record for
- 15 the **DONOR** registry.
- 16 (3) The secretary of state may fulfill the requirements of
- 17 subsection (2) by 1 or more of the following methods:
- (a) Providing printed material enclosed with a mailed notice
- 19 for the issuance or renewal of an official state personal
- 20 identification card.
- 21 (b) Providing printed material to an applicant who personally
- 22 appears at a secretary of state branch office.
- 23 (c) Through electronic information transmittals for
- 24 applications processed by electronic means.
- 25 (4) Until January 1, 2007, if an applicant indicates a
- 26 willingness under this section to have his or her name placed on
- 27 the registry described in subsection (2)(a)(ii), the secretary of

- 1 state shall within 10 days forward the applicant's name, address,
- 2 and date of birth to the organ donor registry maintained by
- 3 Michigan's federally designated organ procurement organization or
- 4 its successor organization. The secretary of state may forward
- 5 information under this subsection by mail or by electronic means.
- 6 The secretary of state shall not maintain a record of the name or
- 7 address of an individual who indicates a willingness to have his or
- 8 her name placed on the organ donor registry after forwarding that
- 9 information to the organ donor registry under this subsection.
- 10 Information about an applicant's indication of a willingness to
- 11 have his or her name placed on the organ donor registry obtained by
- 12 the secretary of state under subsection (2) and forwarded under
- 13 this subsection is exempt from disclosure under section 13(1)(d) of
- 14 the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.243.
- 15 (4) (5)—The secretary of state shall prescribe the form of the
- 16 identification card. The secretary of state shall designate on the
- 17 identification card a space where the applicant may place a sticker
- 18 or decal of the uniform size as the secretary may specify to
- 19 indicate that the cardholder carries a separate emergency medical
- 20 information card. The sticker or decal may be provided by any
- 21 person, hospital, school, medical group, or association interested
- 22 in assisting in implementing the emergency medical information
- 23 card, but shall meet the specifications of the secretary of state.
- 24 The sticker or decal also may be used to indicate that the
- 25 cardholder has designated 1 or more patient advocates in accordance
- 26 with section 5506 of the estates and protected individuals code,
- 27 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.5506. The emergency medical information card,

- 1 carried separately by the cardholder, may contain the information
- 2 described in subsection (2)(c), information concerning the
- 3 cardholder's patient advocate designation, other emergency medical
- 4 information, or an indication as to where the cardholder has stored
- 5 or registered emergency medical information. An original
- 6 identification card or the renewal of an existing identification
- 7 card issued to a person less than 21 years of age shall be portrait
- 8 or vertical in form and an identification card issued to a person
- 9 21 years of age or over shall be landscape or horizontal in form.
- 10 Except as otherwise required in this act, other information
- 11 required on the identification card under this act may appear on
- 12 the identification card in a form prescribed by the secretary of
- 13 state.
- 14 (5) (6) The identification card shall not contain a
- 15 fingerprint or finger image of the applicant.
- 16 (6) (7) Except as provided in this subsection, the secretary
- 17 of state may—SHALL retain and use a person's DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHIC
- 18 image and signature described in subsection (1)(b) only for
- 19 programs administered by the secretary of state AS SPECIFICALLY
- 20 AUTHORIZED BY LAW. Except as provided in this subsection, the
- 21 secretary of state shall not use a person's image unless written
- 22 permission for that purpose is granted by the person to the
- 23 secretary of state or specific enabling legislation permitting the
- 24 use is enacted into law. A law enforcement agency of this state
- 25 shall have access to any information retained by the secretary of
- 26 state under this subsection. The information may be utilized for
- 27 any law enforcement purpose unless otherwise prohibited by law. The

- 1 department of state police shall provide to the secretary of state
- 2 updated lists of persons required under section 5a of the sex
- 3 offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to maintain a
- 4 valid operator's or chauffeur's license or an official state
- 5 personal identification card and the secretary of state shall make
- 6 images of those persons available to the department of state police
- 7 as provided in the sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL
- 8 28.721 to 28.732. A PERSON'S DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHIC IMAGE OR
- 9 SIGNATURE SHALL ONLY BE USED AS FOLLOWS:
- 10 (A) BY A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY FOR A
- 11 LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY LAW.
- 12 (B) BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR A USE SPECIFICALLY
- 13 AUTHORIZED BY LAW.
- 14 (C) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL FORWARD TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 15 STATE POLICE THE IMAGES OF PERSONS REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 16 THE SEX OFFENDERS REGISTRATION ACT, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 TO
- 17 28.736, UPON THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE PROVIDING THE SECRETARY
- 18 OF STATE AN UPDATED LIST OF THOSE PERSONS.
- 19 (D) AS NECESSARY TO COMPLY WITH A LAW OF THIS STATE OR THE
- 20 UNITED STATES.
- 21 (7) (8)—If a person presents evidence of statutory blindness
- 22 as provided in 1978 PA 260, MCL 393.351 to 393.368, and is issued
- 23 or is the holder of an official state personal identification card,
- 24 the secretary of state shall mark the person's identification card
- 25 in a manner that clearly indicates that the cardholder is legally
- 26 blind.
- 27 (8) (9) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of state

- 1 shall maintain a record of an individual who indicates a
- 2 willingness to have his or her name placed on the DONOR registry
- 3 described in subsection (2)(a)(ii). Information about a person's
- 4 indication of a willingness to have his or her name placed on the
- 5 DONOR registry that is obtained by the secretary of state and
- 6 forwarded under this section is exempt from disclosure under
- 7 section 13(1)(d) of the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442,
- 8 MCL 15.243. The AS REQUIRED IN SECTION 10120 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH
- 9 CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10120, THE secretary of state shall
- 10 establish and maintain the organ, tissue, and eye donor registry in
- 11 a manner that COMPLIES WITH THAT SECTION AND THAT provides
- 12 electronic access, including, but not limited to, the transfer of
- 13 data to this state's federally designated organ procurement
- 14 organizations, their ORGANIZATION OR ITS successor organizations,
- 15 and ORGANIZATION, tissue BANKS, and eye banks. with limitations on
- 16 the use of and access to the donor registry as determined by the
- 17 secretary of state.
- 18 (9) (10) An official state personal identification card may
- 19 contain an identifier for voter registration purposes.
- 20 (10) An official state personal identification card may SHALL
- 21 contain information appearing in electronic or machine readable
- 22 codes needed to conduct a transaction with the secretary of state.
- 23 The information shall be limited to the person's identification
- 24 card number, birth date, expiration date, FULL LEGAL NAME, DATE OF
- 25 TRANSACTION, GENDER, ADDRESS, STATE OF ISSUANCE, and other
- 26 information necessary for use with electronic devices, machine
- 27 readers, or automatic teller machines and shall not contain the

- 1 person's name, address, driving record , or other personal
- 2 identifier. The identification card shall identify the encoded
- 3 information.
- 4 (11) An official state personal identification card shall be
- 5 issued only upon authorization of the secretary of state, and shall
- 6 be manufactured in a manner to prohibit as nearly as possible the
- 7 ability to reproduce, alter, counterfeit, forge, or duplicate the
- 8 identification card without ready detection.
- 9 (12) Except as otherwise provided in this act, an applicant
- 10 shall pay a fee of \$10.00 to the secretary of state for each
- 11 original or renewal identification card issued. The department of
- 12 treasury shall deposit the fees received and collected under this
- 13 section in the state treasury to the credit of the general fund.
- 14 The legislature shall appropriate the fees credited to the general
- 15 fund under this act to the secretary of state for the
- 16 administration of this act. Appropriations from the Michigan
- 17 transportation fund created under section 10 of 1951 PA 51, MCL
- 18 247.660, shall not be used to compensate the secretary of state for
- 19 costs incurred and services performed under this section.
- 20 (13) An original or renewal official state personal
- 21 identification card expires on the birthday of the person to whom
- 22 it is issued in the fourth year following the date of issuance OR
- 23 ON THE DATE THE PERSON IS NO LONGER CONSIDERED TO BE LEGALLY
- 24 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES UNDER SECTION 1, WHICHEVER IS EARLIER.
- 25 The secretary of state shall not issue an official state personal
- 26 identification card under this act for a period greater than 4
- 27 years. Except as provided in this subsection, a person may apply

- 1 for a renewal of an official state personal identification card by
- 2 mail or by other methods prescribed by the secretary of state. The
- 3 secretary of state shall require renewal in person by a person
- 4 required under section 5a of the sex offenders registration act,
- 5 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to maintain a valid operator's or
- 6 chauffeur's license or official state personal identification card.
- 7 (14) The secretary of state shall waive the fee under this
- 8 section if the applicant is any of the following:
- 9 (a) A person 65 years of age or older.
- 10 (b) A person who has had his or her operator's or chauffeur's
- 11 license suspended, revoked, or denied under the Michigan vehicle
- 12 code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, because of a mental or
- 13 physical infirmity or disability.
- 14 (c) A person who presents evidence of statutory blindness as
- 15 provided in 1978 PA 260, MCL 393.351 to 393.368.
- 16 (d) A person who presents other good cause for a fee waiver.
- 17 (e) Beginning January 1, 2007, a A person who wishes to add or
- 18 remove a heart insignia described in subsection $\frac{(1)(f)}{(1)}(1)(D)$.
- 19 (15) A person who has been issued an official state personal
- 20 identification card shall apply for a renewal official state
- 21 personal identification card if the person changes his or her name.
- 22 (16) A person who has been issued an official state personal
- 23 identification card shall apply for a corrected identification card
- 24 if he or she changes his or her residential RESIDENCE address. The
- 25 secretary of state may correct the address on an identification
- 26 card by a method prescribed by the secretary of state. A fee shall
- 27 not be charged for a change of residential RESIDENCE address.

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- 1 (17) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (15) and
- 2 (16), a person who has been issued an official state personal
- 3 identification card may apply for a renewal official state personal
- 4 identification card for 1 or more of the following reasons:
- 5 (a) The person wants to change any information on the
- 6 identification card.
- 7 (b) An identification card issued under this act is lost,
- 8 destroyed, or mutilated, or becomes illegible.
- 9 (18) A person may indicate on an official state personal
- 10 identification card in a place designated by the secretary of state
- 11 his or her blood type, emergency contact information, immunization
- 12 data, medication data, OR a statement that the person is deaf. τ
- or, until January 1, 2007, a statement that the person has made an
- 14 anatomical gift under part 101 of the public health code, 1978 PA
- 15 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10109.
- 16 (19) If an applicant provides proof to the secretary of state
- 17 that he or she is a minor who has been emancipated under 1968 PA
- 18 293, MCL 722.1 to 722.6, the official state personal identification
- 19 card shall bear the designation of the individual's emancipated
- 20 status in a manner prescribed by the secretary of state.
- 21 (20) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of state
- 22 shall inquire of each person who applies for or who holds an
- 23 official state personal identification card, in person or by mail,
- 24 whether he or she agrees to participate in the organ, tissue, and
- 25 eye ANATOMICAL GIFT donor registry under part 101 of the public
- 26 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10109 333.10123. A
- 27 person who has agreed to participate in that THE DONOR registry

- 1 shall not be considered to have revoked that agreement solely
- 2 because the person's official state personal identification card
- 3 has expired. Enrollment in the organ, tissue, and eye donor
- 4 registry constitutes a legal agreement that remains binding and in
- 5 effect after the donor's death regardless of the expressed desires
- 6 of the deceased donor's next of kin who may oppose the donor's
- 7 organ, tissue, or eye donation ANATOMICAL GIFT.
- 8 (21) A valid official state personal identification card
- 9 presented by the person to whom the card is issued shall be
- 10 considered the same as a valid state of Michigan driver license
- 11 when identification is requested except as otherwise specifically
- 12 provided by law.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 14 unless House Bill No. 4940 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into
- **15** law.
