SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6367

A bill to establish a program to designate, promote, and market certain food and agricultural products grown, processed, and manufactured in this state; to provide for certain powers for certain state departments and agencies; to provide for certain grants to certain persons; and to provide for the promulgation of rules.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "select Michigan act".
- 3 Sec. 2. (1) The Michigan department of agriculture shall
- 4 establish a select Michigan program in an effort to clearly
- 5 designate food and agricultural products grown, processed, or
- 6 manufactured in this state.

- 1 (2) The program established under subsection (1) shall be
- 2 designed to provide at least the following:
- 3 (a) The increasing of the marketing opportunities for, and the
- 4 awareness and purchasing of, Michigan-grown, processed, and
- 5 manufactured food and agricultural products.
- 6 (b) The forming of partnerships with other public and private
- 7 institutions, universities and colleges, commodity groups,
- 8 manufacturers, retailers, and other entities to implement this act.
- 9 (c) The establishing of a procedure for application for grants
- 10 and other forms of funding for the implementation of this act.
- 11 Sec. 3. As allowed by law, the Michigan department of
- 12 agriculture may provide for the trademarking or protection of a
- 13 select Michigan logo and other identifying marking. The department
- 14 may design marketing materials, develop messages or slogans, or
- 15 both, and may conduct promotions and educational events and
- 16 activities to promote the sale of Michigan food and agricultural
- 17 products.
- 18 Sec. 4. The Michigan department of agriculture may accept
- 19 funds from any private or public source for implementation of this
- 20 act.
- 21 Sec. 5. The Michigan department of agriculture may promulgate
- 22 rules under the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 23 MCL 24.201 to 24.328, to implement this act.
