

HOUSE BILL No. 4759

May 15, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Acciavatti, Hoogendyk, Horn, Stahl, Opsommer, Meltzer and Meekhof and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

by amending section 5c (MCL 28.425c), as amended by 2002 PA 719; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5c. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol shall be in
2 a form, with the same dimensions as a Michigan operator license,

1 prescribed by the department of state police. The license shall
2 contain all of the following:

3 (a) The licensee's full name and date of birth.

4 (b) A photograph and a physical description of the licensee.

5 (c) A statement of the effective dates of the license.

6 (d) An indication of exceptions authorized by this act
7 applicable to the licensee.

8 (e) An indication whether the license is a duplicate.

9 (2) ~~Subject to section 5o and except~~ **EXCEPT** as otherwise
10 provided by law, a license to carry a concealed pistol issued by
11 the county concealed weapon licensing board authorizes the licensee
12 to do all of the following:

13 (a) Carry a pistol concealed on or about his or her person
14 anywhere in this state.

15 (b) Carry a pistol in a vehicle, whether concealed or not
16 concealed, anywhere in this state.

17 Enacting section 1. Section 5o of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.425o, is
18 repealed.
