A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 601b (MCL 257.601b), as amended by 2003 PA 314.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 601b. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this

 act, a person responsible for a moving violation in a work zone, at

 an emergency scene, or in a school zone during the period beginning

 30 minutes before school in the morning and through 30 minutes

 after school in the afternoon ANY OF THE FOLLOWING is subject to a

 fine that is double the fine otherwise prescribed for that moving

 violation: -
 - (A) A WORK ZONE.
 - (B) A RESIDENTIAL ZONE.
