- 1 SEC. 4FF. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON SUBJECT TO
- 2 THE TAX UNDER THIS ACT MAY EXCLUDE FROM THE GROSS PROCEEDS USED FOR
- 3 THE COMPUTATION OF THE TAX THE SALE OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS
- 4 IF THE SALE IS MADE BETWEEN 12:01 A.M. ON THE FOURTH FRIDAY IN
- 5 AUGUST AND 11:59 P.M. THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY EACH YEAR:
- 6 (A) CLOTHING IF THE SALES PRICE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL ITEM IS NOT 7 GREATER THAN \$100.00.
- 8 (B) SCHOOL SUPPLIES IF THE SALES PRICE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL ITEM
  9 IS NOT GREATER THAN \$50.00.
  - (C) COMPUTER SOFTWARE IF THE SALES PRICE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL

- 13 (A) "CLOTHING" MEANS ALL HUMAN WEARING APPAREL SUITABLE FOR
- 14 GENERAL USE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COATS, JACKETS, HATS,
- 15 HOSIERY, SCARVES, SHOES, OR CLOTH AND OTHER MATERIALS USED TO MAKE
- 16 SCHOOL UNIFORMS.
- 17 (B) "CLOTHING ACCESSORIES OR EQUIPMENT" MEANS INCIDENTAL ITEMS
- 18 WORN ON THE PERSON OR IN CONJUNCTION WITH CLOTHING, INCLUDING, BUT
- 19 NOT LIMITED TO, JEWELRY, HANDBAGS, HANDKERCHIEFS, UMBRELLAS,
- 20 SCARVES, TIES, WATCHBANDS, OR WATCHES.
- 21 (C) "SPORT OR RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT" MEANS ITEMS DESIGNED FOR
- 22 HUMAN USE AND WORN IN CONJUNCTION WITH AN ATHLETIC OR RECREATIONAL
- 23 ACTIVITY THAT ARE NOT SUITABLE FOR GENERAL USE. SPORT OR
- 24 RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, BALLET
- 25 SHOES, CLEATED ATHLETIC SHOES, SHIN GUARDS, AND SKI BOOTS.
