- 23 THE BOARD. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO RESERVISTS OR NATIONAL
- 24 GUARD MEMBERS ON ACTIVE DUTY FOR ANNUAL TRAINING THAT IS A
- 25 REGULARLY SCHEDULED OBLIGATION FOR RESERVISTS OR MEMBERS OF THE
- 26 NATIONAL GUARD FOR TRAINING AND IS NOT PART OF A MOBILIZATION.
