SENATE BILL No. 1245

March 27, 2008, Introduced by Senators JACOBS, ANDERSON, CHERRY, OLSHOVE, GLEASON, GARCIA, CLARK-COLEMAN and WHITMER and referred to the Committee on Energy Policy and Public Utilities.

A bill to amend 1971 PA 227, entitled

"An act to prescribe the rights and duties of parties to home solicitation sales; to regulate certain telephone solicitation; to provide for the powers and duties of certain state officers and entities; and to prescribe penalties and remedies,"

by amending section 1b (MCL 445.111b), as added by 2002 PA 612.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1b. (1) At the beginning of a telephone solicitation, a person making a telephone solicitation to a residential telephone subscriber shall state his or her name and the full name of the organization or other person on whose behalf the call was initiated and provide a telephone number of the organization or other person on request. A natural person must be available to answer the telephone number at any time when telephone solicitations are being

- 13 to whom a THE telephone solicitation is made so that the telephone
- 14 number OR NAME of the caller TELEPHONE SOLICITOR is not displayed
- 15 on the telephone of the residential telephone subscriber.
