A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 642a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 642A. (1) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, A
- 2 COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION, OR A LOCAL AUTHORITY MAY DESIGNATE 1 OR
- 3 MORE LANES OF ANY PORTION OF A HIGHWAY WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION AS
- 4 BEING LIMITED FOR USE ONLY BY INDIVIDUALS OPERATING MOTOR VEHICLES
- 5 OCCUPIED BY A SPECIFIC NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE
- 6 STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OR THAT COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION
- 7 OR LOCAL AUTHORITY. THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OR THAT
- 8 COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION OR LOCAL AUTHORITY SHALL, AT A MINIMUM,
- PLACE SIGNS AT THE BEGINNING OF, AND END OF, THAT PORTION OF A

- 20 THE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION, OR THE LOCAL AUTHORITY.
- 21 (F) HE OR SHE IS RESPONDING TO A ROAD OR TRAFFIC HAZARD.
- 22 (4) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
- 23 CIVIL INFRACTION.
