**HOUSE BILL 5858 (H-1) DRAFT 1**

Total state share of the projects contained within this bill is \$462.2 million. The current available bond capacity is about \$611 million. Rental rates are usually between 9% and 11% per year. With the total state share being \$462.2 million, the annual debt service payments for these projects will be between \$41.6 and \$50.8 million. These payments will be made for 15 to 17 years.
