SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4657

A bill to amend 1939 PA 3, entitled

"An act to provide for the regulation and control of public and certain private utilities and other services affected with a public interest within this state; to provide for alternative energy suppliers; to provide for licensing; to include municipally owned utilities and other providers of energy under certain provisions of this act; to create a public service commission and to prescribe and define its powers and duties; to abolish the Michigan public utilities commission and to confer the powers and duties vested by law on the public service commission; to provide for the continuance, transfer, and completion of certain matters and proceedings; to abolish automatic adjustment clauses; to prohibit certain rate increases without notice and hearing; to qualify residential energy conservation programs permitted under state law for certain federal exemption; to create a fund; to provide for a restructuring of the manner in which energy is provided in this state; to encourage the utilization of resource recovery facilities; to prohibit certain acts and practices of providers of energy; to allow for the securitization of stranded costs; to reduce rates; to provide for appeals; to provide appropriations; to declare the effect and purpose of this act; to prescribe remedies and penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 460.1 to 460.11) by adding section 9k.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 9K. (1) NO LATER THAN 2 YEARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF 1
- THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION AND EVERY 2 YEARS AFTER 2
- 3 THAT DATE, THE COMMISSION SHALL FILE A REPORT WITH THE LEGISLATURE
- 4 PRESENTING RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE ELIMINATION OF BARRIERS TO
- 5 ASSISTING SENIOR CITIZENS OR CUSTOMERS WHO MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 6 FEDERAL AND STATE ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS AS WELL AS
- RECOMMENDATIONS TO CHANGES IN SHUT-OFF PROCEDURES. 7
- (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL WORK WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF HUMAN 8
- 9 SERVICES AND COMMUNITY HEALTH, PROVIDERS, AND SOCIAL SERVICES
- 10 AGENCIES TO IDENTIFY BARRIERS TO ASSISTING SENIOR CITIZENS OR
- 11 CUSTOMERS WHO MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL AND STATE ENERGY
- 12 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.
- (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION: 13
- (A) "PROVIDER" MEANS AN ELECTRIC UTILITY, MUNICIPALLY OWNED 14
- 15 ELECTRIC OR NATURAL GAS UTILITY, COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC UTILITY, OR
- ALTERNATIVE ELECTRIC SUPPLIER, OR A NATURAL GAS UTILITY AS DEFINED 16
- 17 IN SECTION 9.
- 18 (B) "SENIOR CITIZEN" MEANS A CUSTOMER OF A PROVIDER WHO IS 65
- 19 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.
