SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5018

A bill to amend 1984 PA 270, entitled "Michigan strategic fund act,"

(MCL 125.2001 to 125.2094) by adding chapter 3A.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER 3A
- 2 SEC. 38. (1) THE LEGISLATURE FINDS AND DECLARES THAT THE
- 3 ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS CHAPTER TO PROMOTE THIS STATE AND
- 4 THE CREATION OF JOBS IN THIS STATE ARE A PUBLIC PURPOSE AND OF
- 5 PARAMOUNT CONCERN IN THE INTEREST OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND
- 6 GENERAL WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THIS STATE. IT IS THE INTENT OF
- 7 THE LEGISLATURE THAT THE ECONOMIC BENEFITS AND CREATION OF JOBS

- 1 RESULTING FROM THIS CHAPTER SHALL ACCRUE SUBSTANTIALLY WITHIN THIS
- 2 STATE.
- 3 (2) ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS CHAPTER SHALL NOT BE
- 4 CONSIDERED A PROJECT, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, OR A PRODUCT
- 5 ASSISTED BY THE FUND FOR PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 1 OR 2.
- 6 SEC. 39. (1) THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND IS CREATED AS A
- 7 SEPARATE FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY AND SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY
- 8 THE STATE TREASURER.
- 9 (2) THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND SHALL BE USED TO PROMOTE
- 10 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOB CREATION IN THIS STATE THROUGH THE
- 11 PROMOTION OF TOURISM.
- 12 (3) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION
- 13 FUND ALL AMOUNTS DESIGNATED FOR THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND BY THIS
- 14 CHAPTER AND SECTION 21 OF THE USE TAX ACT, 1937 PA 94, MCL 205.111.
- 15 (4) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF
- 16 MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND MONEY IN THE SAME MANNER AS ALL OTHER FUNDS
- 17 ARE INVESTED. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE MICHIGAN
- 18 PROMOTION FUND THE INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM THE FUND.
- 19 (5) MONEY DEPOSITED, FUNDS GRANTED, OR FUNDS RECEIVED AS GIFTS
- 20 OR DONATIONS TO THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR
- 21 DISBURSEMENT WHEN DEPOSITED. THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND IS NOT
- 22 REOUIRED TO MAINTAIN A MINIMUM BALANCE. FUNDS MAY BE DISBURSED FROM
- 23 THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND AT ANY TIME. THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION
- 24 FUND SHALL NOT BE USED TO PROMOTE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT.
- 25 (6) MONEY IN THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE
- 26 STATE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND AND
- 27 SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE STATE GENERAL FUND.

- 1 (7) THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2010, THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND MAY
- 2 BORROW MONEY AND ISSUE NOTES TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT FUNDS FOR
- 3 ACHIEVING THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND'S PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES,
- 4 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO PAY THE COSTS
- 5 FOR PROMOTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND JOB CREATION IN THIS STATE
- 6 THROUGH THE PROMOTION OF TOURISM; FOR ALL OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE
- 7 MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND INCIDENT TO AND NECESSARY OR CONVENIENT TO
- 8 CARRY OUT THE MICHIGAN PROMOTION FUND'S PURPOSES, OBJECTIVES, AND
- 9 POWERS; AND FOR ANY COMBINATION OF THE THESE.
