A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 7212 (MCL 333.7212), as amended by 2002 PA 710.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 7212. (1) The following controlled substances are
