THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 430a. (1) An individual shall not intentionally engage in
 or attempt to engage in human cloning.
 - (2) Subsection (1) THIS SUBSECTION does not prohibit scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically prohibited by that UNDER THIS subsection.
 - (2) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT INTENTIONALLY TRANSPORT, ATTEMPT TO TRANSPORT, OR CAUSE TO BE TRANSPORTED INTO THIS STATE A HUMAN EMBRYO CREATED THROUGH HUMAN CLONING.
 - (3) An individual who violates subsection (1) THIS SECTION is

- 1 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 10
- 2 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000,000.00, or both.
