SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 1109

A bill to amend 1966 PA 261, entitled

"An act to provide for the apportionment of county boards of commissioners; to prescribe the size of the board; to provide for appeals; to prescribe the manner of election of the members of the county board of commissioners; to provide for compensation of members; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 46.403).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The county apportionment commission shall consist
- 2 of the county clerk, the county treasurer, the prosecuting
- 3 attorney, and the statutory county chairperson of each of the 2
- 4 political parties receiving the greatest number of votes cast for
- 5 the office of secretary of state in the last preceding general
- 6 election. If a county does not have a statutory chairperson of a
- 7 political party, the 2 additional members shall be a party

- 1 representative from each of the 2 political parties receiving the
- 2 greatest number of votes cast for the office of secretary of state
- 3 in the last preceding general election and appointed by the
- 4 chairperson of the state central committee for each of the
- 5 political parties. The clerk shall convene the COUNTY apportionment
- 6 commission and they shall adopt their rules of procedure. Three
- 7 members of the COUNTY apportionment commission shall be a quorum
- 8 sufficient to conduct its business. All action of the COUNTY
- 9 apportionment commission shall be by majority vote of the
- 10 commission.
- 11 (2) The business which THAT the COUNTY apportionment
- 12 commission may perform shall be conducted at a public meeting held
- 13 in compliance with Act No. 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, being
- 14 sections 15.261 to 15.275 of the Michigan Compiled Laws THE OPEN
- 15 MEETINGS ACT, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 TO 15.275. Public notice of
- 16 the time, date, and place of the meeting shall be given in the

- 19 (3) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 20 retained by the COUNTY APPORTIONMENT commission in the performance
- 21 of an official function shall be made available to the public in
- 22 compliance with Act No. 442 of the Public Acts of 1976, being
- 23 sections 15.231 to 15.246 of the Michigan Compiled Laws THE FREEDOM
- 24 OF INFORMATION ACT, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 TO 15.246.
- 25 (4) IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, THE DUTIES
- 26 OF THE COUNTY APPORTIONMENT COMMISSION INCLUDE ESTABLISHING SINGLE-
- 27 MEMBER COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION DISTRICTS AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 6 OF
