## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 269. If a vacancy occurs in the office of county road
- 2 commissioner, a qualified person shall be appointed to fill the
- 3 vacancy by the county board of commissioners. IF A VACANCY OCCURS
- 4 IN A SINGLE-MEMBER COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION DISTRICT, A QUALIFIED
- 5 PERSON FROM THAT SINGLE-MEMBER DISTRICT SHALL BE APPOINTED TO FILL
- 6 THE VACANCY BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS. The person so
- 7 appointed shall take the oath of office, give bond in the manner
- 8 required by law, and hold office for the remainder of the unexpired
- term and until a successor is elected and qualified. However, in a

- 1 county in which county road commissioners are elected, if the next
- 2 general November election is to be held more than 182 days after
- 3 the vacancy occurs, and it is not the general November election at
- 4 which a successor in office would be elected if there were no

- 7 manner provided by law and qualifies for office. The successor
