by amending section 20d (MCL 38.20d), as amended by 2002 PA 93.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20d. (1) On and after July 1, 1974 AND BEFORE OCTOBER 1,
- 2 2009, hospitalization and medical coverage insurance premium
- 3 payable by any retirant or his or her beneficiary and his or her
- 4 dependents under any group health plan authorized by the Michigan
- 5 civil service commission and the department of management and
- 6 budget shall be paid by the retirement board from the health
- 7 insurance reserve fund created in section 11. ON AND AFTER OCTOBER
- 8 1, 2009, HOSPITALIZATION AND MEDICAL COVERAGE INSURANCE PREMIUM
