A bill to provide for the creation and operation of a program to allow public employers to participate in the state health plan; and to prescribe powers and duties of certain state officers and agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Commission" means the civil service commission.
- 3 (b) "Public employer" means a city, village, township, county,
- 4 or other political subdivision of this state; any
- 5 intergovernmental, metropolitan, or local department, agency, or
- 6 authority, or other local political subdivision; a school district,
 - a public school academy, or an intermediate school district, as
 - those terms are defined in the revised school code, 1976 PA 451,

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- 1 MCL 380.1 to 380.1852; a community college or junior college
- 2 described in section 7 of article VIII of the state constitution of
- 3 1963; or an institution of higher education described in section 4
- 4 of article VIII of the state constitution of 1963.
- 5 (c) "State health plan" means a benefit plan for providing
- 6 medical, optical, or dental benefits to employees or their
- 7 dependents that this state offers to a nonexclusively represented
- 8 employee in the classified state civil service.
- 9 Sec. 2. (1) The commission shall create and operate a program
- 10 to allow a public employer to participate in a state health plan by
- 11 purchasing the state health plan benefits for its employees.
- 12 (2) The program shall provide that the public employer shall
- 13 pay the full cost to the state of the state health plan coverage
- 14 not later than the first day of the month for which coverage is
- 15 sought or as otherwise determined by the commission.
