## **HOUSE BILL No. 4275**

February 17, 2009, Introduced by Rep. McMillin and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to apportion the state's expenses for the cost of health benefits for state employees.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "state
- 2 employee health benefits cost apportionment act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Health benefits" means employee medical, dental, or
- 5 optical insurance or coverage.
- 6 (b) "State employee" means a classified or unclassified member
- 7 of the state civil service or an unclassified employee of the
- 8 executive, legislative, or judicial branch of this state's
- 9 government.
  - Sec. 5. Except as provided in section 7, this state shall not

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- 1 pay a higher percentage of the premium or other cost of health
- 2 benefits for each state employee than the average percentage paid
- 3 for state employees by all the states of the United States as
- 4 determined in the most recent survey published by the national
- 5 conference of state legislatures.
- 6 Sec. 7. If a contract or collective bargaining agreement that
- 7 is inconsistent with section 5 is in effect for a group of state
- 8 employees before January 1, 2010, the requirements of section 5 do
- 9 not apply to that group of employees until the contract or
- 10 collective bargaining agreement expires. The requirements of
- 11 section 5 apply to any extension or renewal of the contract or
- 12 collective bargaining agreement that begins on or after January 1,
- **13** 2010.
- 14 Sec. 9. The requirements of section 5 apply to health benefits
- 15 provided to all state employees to the greatest extent consistent
- 16 with constitutionally allocated powers.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect January 1, 2010.

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
