THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 169. Disturbance of religious meetings Any A person who 7 on the first day of the week, or at any other time, shall wilfully
- 3 interrupt WILLFULLY INTERRUPTS or disturb DISTURBS any assembly of
- 4 people met for the worship of God, within the place of such IN
- 5 WHICH THE meeting IS HELD or out OUTSIDE of it, shall be IS guilty
- 6 of a misdemeanor PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93
- 7 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
