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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4647**

March 19, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Johnson and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to provide for the levy, collection, and administration of an excise tax on the sale of sexually explicit matter in this state; to provide for the disposition of the proceeds of the excise tax; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments; and to provide for certain exemptions.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
  "sexually explicit matter tax act".

Sec. 2. As used in this act:

- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- (b) "Sexually explicit matter" means that term as defined insection 3 of 1978 PA 33, MCL 722.673.
- Sec. 3. (1) An excise tax is levied on the sale of sexually explicit matter in this state.

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- 1 (2) The rate of the excise tax is 10% of the sale price of the
- 2 sexually explicit matter.
- 3 Sec. 4. (1) The excise tax shall be collected at the same time
- 4 and in the same manner as the tax imposed under the general sales
- 5 tax act, 1933 PA 167, MCL 205.51 to 205.78.
- 6 (2) The excise tax imposed by this act shall be administered
- 7 by the department under 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.1 to 205.31.
- 8 (3) The state treasurer shall prescribe the forms necessary
- 9 for the administration of this act and may promulgate necessary
- 10 rules under the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 11 MCL 24.201 to 24.328.
- 12 Sec. 5. A taxpayer may reimburse himself or herself by adding
- 13 the amount of the excise tax to the cost of the sexually explicit
- 14 matter.
- 15 Sec. 6. The proceeds from the collection of the excise tax
- 16 imposed under this act shall be deposited with the state treasurer
- 17 and credited to the general fund of this state.

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
