## **HOUSE BILL No. 5135**

June 23, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Paul Scott and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2006 PA 562, and by adding section 811r.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 811e. (1) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of state may develop a fund-raising plate as provided in this section.
- 3 (2) A start-up fee of \$15,000.00 shall be paid for any new
- 4 fund-raising plate authorized under this section, which fee shall
- ${f 5}$  be deposited in the transportation administration collection fund
- 6 to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and issuing fund
  - raising plates. If the fee described in this subsection is not paid
  - within 18 months  $\frac{\text{of-AFTER}}{\text{AFTER}}$  the effective date of the public act that
  - authorizes the development and issuance of a fund-raising plate,

- 4 (3) Not less than 3 years after the secretary of state first

- 2 SEC. 811R. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
- 3 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A CHOOSE LIFE FUND-
- 4 RAISING PLATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DESIGN THE FUND-RAISING

- 22 (B) FIFTY PERCENT TO THE ULTRASOUND EQUIPMENT FUND ESTABLISHED
- 23 IN SECTION 9141 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 24 333.9141.
- 25 (5) BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2011, THE RECIPIENTS
- 26 OF THE FUNDS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE
- 27 EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER
