HOUSE BILL No. 5595

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending sections 803e, 803i, 803j, 803k, and 803*l* (MCL 257.803e, 257.803i, 257.803j, 257.803k, and 257.803*l*), section 803e as amended by 2003 PA 30, section 803i as amended by 1998 PA 68, sections 803j and 803k as amended by 1999 PA 183, and section 803*l* as amended by 2000 PA 77.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and shall have the words "exprisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.

(2) A person who was a member of the armed services during
 World War I may make application to the secretary of state for a
 special registration plate - which THAT shall be inscribed with
 special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and
 shall have the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the
 registration number.

7 (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment 8 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the 9 10 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make 11 application to the secretary of state for a special registration 12 plate - which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed 13 14 beneath the registration number.

15 (4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may make application to the secretary of state for a special 16 17 registration plate which THAT shall be inscribed with special identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded 18 19 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition, 20 the special registration plate described under this subsection 21 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart 22 medal.

(5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied
by any proof of the applicant having been a prisoner of war, World
War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, or recipient of the purple
heart medal that the secretary of state may require. The

application for a special registration plate shall also be
 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF
 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION
 PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

5 (6) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service 6 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application for a 8 9 special registration plate under this section and who makes payment of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with 10 11 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special 12 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for 13 14 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. One person in any household is entitled to 1 special registration plate 15 issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from payment of the tax 16 17 provided in section 801. The person who is issued an additional 18 special registration plate under subsection (1) shall be assessed 19 the applicable tax provided for in section 801. A person issued 1 20 or more special registration plates under subsection (2), (3), or 21 (4) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801.

(7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

(8) The special registration plate issued under this section
expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new
plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for

renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
 \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A
 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RENEWED UNDER THIS
 SUBSECTION. The applicant is not required to furnish the proof
 provided in subsection (5).

Sec. 803i. (1) A person who was or is a member of the national
guard may apply to the secretary of state for a special
registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate
vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the
words "national guard" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) A person who was or is a member of the military reserve may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers.

(3) A person who was a member of any branch of the armed services of the United States, who has retired or been granted an honorable discharge from that branch of the armed forces, and who is not otherwise eligible for a special registration plate under this act may apply to the secretary of state for a special registration plate which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers.

(4) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
form prescribed by the secretary of state and shall be accompanied
by any proof of the applicant being or having been a member of the
national guard or military reserve or a member of any branch of the
armed services of the United States as described in subsection (3)
that the secretary of state may require. The application for a

special registration plate shall also be accompanied with payment
 of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A

(5) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service 5 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 6 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 7 vehicle. A person who is disabled who applies for a special 8 registration plate under this section and who pays the \$5.00 9 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as 10 11 provided in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. 12 The secretary of state shall require the same proof that the 13 applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a 14 permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under subsection (1), (2), or 15 (3) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section 801. 16

17 (6) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other18 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who19 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.

20 (7) The special registration plate issued under this section 21 shall expire EXPIRES on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new 22 plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for 23 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A 24 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RENEWED UNDER THIS 25 26 SUBSECTION. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the 27 proof provided in subsection (4) WITH AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF

Sec. 803j. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed forces during the Korean War may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

(2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 8 9 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied 10 by any proof of the applicant or the applicant's spouse having been 11 a Korean War veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 12 application for a special registration plate shall also be 13 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF 14 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION. 15

(1) A person who was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War or a person whose spouse was a member of the armed services during the Vietnam War may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , which THAT shall display an appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall have the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration numbers.

20 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a 21 form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied 22 by any proof of the applicant or applicant's spouse having been a 23 Vietnam War veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 24 application for a special registration plate shall also be 25 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF 26 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION. 27

5 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall be accompanied 6 by any proof of the applicant or applicant's spouse having been a 7 World War II veteran that the secretary of state may require. The 8 9 application for a special registration plate shall also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF 10 11 STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION 12 PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

13 (3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 special registration 14 plate for each applicant for use on a passenger vehicle. A person 15 who is disabled who makes application for a special registration 16 17 plate under this section and who makes payment of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided 18 19 in section 803f for his or her special registration plate. When new plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for 3 4 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT CHARGE A 5 SERVICE FEE FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RENEWED UNDER THIS 6 SECTION. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the proof 7 provided in subsection (2). 8
