by amending section 1 (MCL 722.41), as amended by 1981 PA 228.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) A person THIS ACT SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED
- 2 AS "JENNA'S LAW".
- 3 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 17 years of age or over may donate
- 4 blood in a voluntary and noncompensatory blood program without the
- 5 necessity of obtaining parental HIS OR HER PARENT'S or LEGAL
- 6 guardian's permission or authorization.
- 7 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 16 YEARS OF AGE MAY DONATE BLOOD IN A
- 8 VOLUNTARY AND NONCOMPENSATORY BLOOD PROGRAM WITH HIS OR HER
- 9 PARENT'S OR LEGAL GUARDIAN'S PERMISSION OR AUTHORIZATION.
