(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 328a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 328A. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF
- 2 STATE IN PERSON IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR WHILE HE OR SHE IS
- 3 OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THIS STATE:
- 4 (A) HE OR SHE IS INVOLVED IN A CRASH RESULTING IN PROPERTY
- 5 DAMAGE OF \$1,000.00 OR MORE.
- 6 (B) HE OR SHE IS INVOLVED IN A CRASH RESULTING IN PERSONAL
- 7 INJURY TO ANY INDIVIDUAL.
- C) HE OR SHE IS STOPPED BY A PEACE OFFICER FOR A VIOLATION OF

- 2 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL REPORT AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 3 (1) WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER THE CRASH OR STOP. THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL
