HOUSE BILL No. 5805

February 11, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Meadows and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 384, entitled "Driver education provider and instructor act," by amending section 37 (MCL 256.657).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 37. (1) A segment 1 curriculum shall include both
 classroom and behind-the-wheel driver education course experience.
 The classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel instruction shall be
 integrated, relate to each other, and meet the following

5 requirements:

6 (a) Each student shall receive not less than 24 hours of
7 classroom instruction. Classroom instruction shall be scheduled to
8 occur as follows:

9 (i) Classroom instruction shall occur not more than 2 hours per10 day.

(*ii*) Classroom instruction shall occur over the course of 3 or
 more weeks.

3 (iii) Classroom instruction of 4 or more hours shall be received4 before the student begins to receive behind-the-wheel instruction.

(*iv*) Behind-the-wheel instruction of 3 or more hours shall be completed before classroom instruction terminates.

7 (b) Each student shall receive not less than 6 hours of
8 behind-the-wheel instruction or substitute hours permitted under
9 this subsection. Behind-the-wheel instruction shall be scheduled to
10 occur as follows:

(i) A student shall receive not more than 1 hour of behind-the-wheel instruction per day.

13 (*ii*) Not more than 1 student shall occupy the front seat of the14 vehicle with the instructor.

15 (*iii*) A driver education motor vehicle shall contain not more16 than 4 students during behind-the-wheel instruction.

17 (*iv*) Not later than 3 weeks after the last classroom
18 instruction has been completed, a student shall complete any
19 remaining required behind-the-wheel instruction.

(v) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a student may receive instruction while operating a motor vehicle at a multiple vehicle driving facility. One hour of instruction received at a multiple vehicle driving facility may substitute as credit for hour of behind-the-wheel experience. A maximum of 2 hours of behind-the-wheel experience can be substituted with instruction received at a multiple vehicle driving facility.

2 (2) A driver education provider classified for teen driver
3 training shall not substitute behind-the-wheel instruction with
4 multiple vehicle driving facility experience until the secretary of
5 state gives the provider written approval for that substitution as
6 provided in this act.

7 (3) A driver education provider classified for teen driver
8 training shall not substitute behind-the-wheel driving experience
9 with simulator device training.

11 12 wheel instruction scheduled to include a mix of classroom and 13 behind-the-wheel instruction throughout the duration of the driver 14 education course, except as otherwise provided in this section. 15 (b) "Observation time" means the time a student in a driver 16 education course sits in the rear seat of a vehicle and observes 17 another student in the front seat behind the wheel operating the 18 controls of the vehicle, responding to driving situations, and with 19 an instructor sitting in the front seat.
